

AVC Fg 52 : Prieuré de Romainmôtier, at Mollens, Berolle, Montricher, Villars-Bozon, and Pampigny, commissaire François Gros of Bière, 1536.

The next terrier covering Mollens is Fg 125 (1608, commissaire Etienne Mayor). The preceding terrier covering Mollens is Fj 5 (1496, commissaire Aymonet Pollens). The citations for reconnaissances recorded by Aymonet Pollens need to be compared with Fj 5 in order to be sure the details are properly understood. This notary uses “patruus” for paternal uncle, in preference to “avunculus”, which he uses in the classical sense of maternal uncle. Many parcels are traced back to the de Mont family in the indefinite past, suggesting that terriers for this family from the 15th Century might be very informative.

Spelling later rendered Davoet is more likely written Davoer here.

A new and less tidy hand begins on fol. 107.

(The word “oriundus” is from the same root as “origin”. The passage may be translated literally as Philippe Boudyn from the parish of Boegy originating, inhabitant of Mollens.)

25 nov 1531, Petrus Girgat dez Cornens habitator dez Mollens filius quondam Girardi Girgas de eodem loco dez Cornens, previously (Aymoneti Pollens) by Johannem Costantyn dez Jussierz gebennensis dyocesis habitatoris apud Mollens... sold to him by Johannes Bonjor b de Morges 24 nov 1501, jx Jacobi et Petri Mathey fratrum filorum quondam Petri Mathey alias dez Ballens... Fol. 34, note Hudricus Bovey is son of Roletus Bovey and Girarda daughter of Johannetus Davoet. Fol. 36 mention pratum Jacobi Monod alias Noblet and Jacobi Boudat et Johannete eius uxoris filie quondam Nycodi Augiez quod fuit quondam Jacobi de Plathea, also continues with mention of Anthonius Mayor and Petrus Mayor dez Ballens. Also fol. 37, mention pratum Stephani Monod alias Cygoen quod fuit dictorum Mayor dez Ballens. 41v Claudius Juennyn

42v Petrus Griffon

07 oct 1529, Petrus Griffon dez Cornens habitator dez Mollens agens in hac parte suo proprio et Gladii Griffon eius fratris..., de bonis Francisci Cuyvt dez Mollens (A. Pollens) que pridem

fuerunt **Johannis Lambert et Jaqueti eius filii et antiquitus Vuilliermete filie Jaquet Soudant uxoris Lambert Curto patris dicti Johannis Lambert**... transferred from Glaudium et Jacobum Cuyt brothers to Griffon 1526. (Note origin of Lambert family in person of children of Lambert Curto !)

44 Claudius Racloz

07 oct 1529, Glaudius Racloz de Bonnaz habitator dez Mollens, de bonis imper Francisco Cuyt abbergatis et accensatis que pridem fuerunt Johannis Lambert et Jaqueti Lambert eius filii (etc., see above)... ultimateque per dictum Franciscum Cuyt (A. Pollens), spectantibus dicto Glaudio Racloz confitenti ex vendicione sibi per Stephanum filium quondam dicti Stephani Cuyt 29 jan 1520 and today confirmed (lods). On fol. 45v, note that (current) Glaudius et Jacobus Cuyt are sons of the late Francisci Cuyt who had obtained the property from Jaqueti Lambert. Fol. 46, subsequenter 17 jun 1531, further reconnaissance regarding property from the Cuyt family, complicated but apparently relating to other relationships of the same ? Franciscus Cuyt?

47v Hudricus Bovey

08 oct 1529, Hudricus Bovey dez Mollens, de bonis Girarda relicte Roleti Bovey filie quondam Johanneti Davoez dez Mollens, ipsius Henrici confitentis quondam matris, and before that by dicti Johanneti Davoez et Jaqueti eius fratris... He is referred to at least once (fol. 66) as Hudricus Bovey alias Davoet.

50 Johannes Morellon junior

23 nov 1529, Johannes Morellon junior filius quondam Johannis Morellon dez Mollens, by succession from his father, and by his father (A. Pollens) recognized and before that by Johannodi Lansenon? On fol. 051v, mentions of various relationships of de Frigidavilla family.

53 Johannes Morellon senior

23 nov 1529, Johannes Morellon senior filius quondam Philiberti Morellon dez Mollens, previously by Mondeti Morellon eiusdem confitentis avi paterni et antiquitus Stephani Boelley

60v Claudius Bolley

10 dec 1529, Glaudius Bolley alias Mathey filius quondam _____ Bolley de eodem loco, At least one property formerly (A. Pollens) by Jacobum et Petrum libiros quondam Petri Mathey alias dez Ballens que pridem fuerent Mermeti Noblet eorumdem Mathey fratrum tutoris, et antiquitus Rolete filie Johannodi Gollyon et Johannete de Bruyt, Jaqueti Mathey, et certorum aliorum. Fol. 63 an item jx **Stephanem Monod alias Cygoen et eius nepotis de bonis quondam Petri Mayor junioris dez Ballens**... On fol. 63v, Item en Mosses medietatem per indiviso cum predicto Jacobo Mathey pro altera medietate unius falcate pratem juxta pratum Anthonii Mayor et eius fratrum dez Ballens a borea, pratum dictorum Mathey et Bolley condvisorum de feudo dominidez Mont a vento pratum heredem Petri dez Mont et plurium aliorum a juria et pratum eyz Gryvel de Sancto Liberio a lacu. (Is this a statement that Claude Mayor de Ballens, resident at Mollens, is the brother of Anthonius? Or is it perhaps a statement about another Claude Mayor or someone else?) On fol. 64, jx **Stephani Monod alias Cigoen et Petri eius nepotis quod fuit quondam Petri Mayor junioris et pridem a Soudant**, and also jx pratum liberorum Francisci et Johannis Monod de bonis Glaudii dez Lavignyez.

(From Fh 137, fol. 850, reconnaissance of Glaudia uxor Glaudii Soudans filiaque Petri Pollet, 07 feb 1508, we see that the person known as Petrus Mayor junior in 1508 was the son-in-law of

Pierre Cigoen. Elsewhere, Stephanus Cigoen alias Monod, son of Pierre Cigoen, is the uncle of Pierre Mayor or Monod son of the late Claude who was the son of Estivent Mayor. In the above account, it looks like Petrus Mayor junior, known to be the son of Mondet Mayor from Fj 5 1497, has died, and that some of his property went to Stephanus Monod alias Cigoen and Cigoen's nephew. In order for all the statements to be true, is it necessary that Pierre junior married a daughter of Pierre Cigoen *and* that Stephanus Cigoen, son of Pierre, married a cousin of Pierre junior? Such a double alliance would make it more likely that descendants of Stephanus Cigoen, if there were any, would be known as Monod.)

66v **Jacobus Mathei**

01 dec 1529, Confessio Jacobi filii quondam Petri Mathey alias dez Ballens dez Mollens, et Glaudii Mayor dez Ballens eius generi suo et conjuncto nomine Mermete eius uxoris filie dicti Jacobi Mathey facta. "Claudius Mayor sutor dez Ballens habitator ipsius loci dez Mollens eius gener". Jacob had made a donation to Claude and Mermete, date not given. Jacob and his brother had made a reconnaissance for Aymonet Pollens, for property que pridem fuerunt Mermeti Noblet eorumdem Mathey fratrum tutoris, and before that by Rolete filie Johannodi Gollyon, Johannete dez Bruyt, as well as Jaqueti Mathey et certorum aliorum (from what follows, these were separate holdings, not jointly owned by these parties). Many families involved, relationships not obviously involving the Mathey family. **The section pertaining to Claude Mayor in his own name begins on fol. 71v**, mentioning paternal succession and the division with his (Claude's) brother Pierre and with Anthoine Mayor of Ballens – thus, in spite of the fact that in the reconnaissances for Pierre Mayor (1531, fol. 146) the brother of Pierre is called Claudius clericus, not sutor, they may actually be the same person! The descriptions of the individual properties have not, so far, directly confirmed this. All of the properties that Claude Mayor sutor holds jointly with Antoine Mayor in the section beginning on fol. 71v match the properties that Antoine Mayor holds jointly with Claude Mayor sutor beginning on fol. 134, but they do not involve properties that are mentioned in the reconnaissance that calls him clericus.

Statement on fol. 71v regarding the provenance of the properties enumerated for Claude in his own name: "... ex succession sua paterna et divisionibus suis inde inter ipsum Gladium confitentem ac Petrum Mayor eius fratrem et Anthonium Mayor dez Ballens factis res et possessions sequentem sitas et jacentes in villa et confinio dez Mollens cum fundis juribus et pertinens suis universis ultimo recognitas in manibus supradicti Aymoneti Pollens commissarii per Michaellem et Petrum dictorum Mayor filiorum quondam Anthonii dou Verney dez Ballens que pridem fuerunt dicti Anthonii dou Verney eorumdem Michaelis et Petri quondam patris et antiquitus Doucete filie Jaqueti Soudant et certorum aliorum infrascriptorum..."

Properties for Claude Mayor:

(In every case, these are properties either owned by Claude in his own name, or else "indivis" with Antoine Mayor, each owning a half interest. However, properties 11 and 12 are a part interest held jointly by Claude and Antoine, the other parts being held by the Cuvit family and others. How do the reconnaissances for the Cuvit family treat these properties? The reconnaissances for Johannes Cuvit and for Jacobus Cuvit senior attribute the other part to Claude Mayor alone, without further details! The reconnaissance for Claude Cuvit leaves out the Mayor claim to the first parcel entirely, but refers to "dictus Mayor" in the description of the second.)

(I.e., these reconnaissances are for residents of Ballens who own property subject to the Priory of Romainmôtier within the commune of Mollens.)

Aymoneti Pollens, and before that? (que pridem) by Anthonii douz Verney their? father (i.e., father of Michel and Pierre), et antiquitus Doucete filie Jaqueti Soudant, ex succession legitime dicti Michaelis eius quondam patris etiamque ex divisionibus imper inter ipsum confitentum ac Petrum Mayor villiam dez Ballens et Glaudium eius fratrem et Michaelem filium quondam Humberti filiique dicti quondam Petri Mayor alias douz Verney condvisores suos factis... Many of the properties are held half by Antoine, Ottonin, and Jean, and the other half by Claude Mayor sutor of Ballens, habitant at Mollens. This Claude is revealed to be the notary?, see fol. 146, who with his brother **Pierre** of Ballens, made a division with Antoine and his brothers, and with **Michel** son of the late Humbert son of the *late* Pierre (evidently meaning the son of the first Antoine douz Verney). The parties in this division, Michel and Pierre, are the ones whose reconnaissances follow on fols. 143 and 146. Other relationships are hinted at, the last half of this document needs further study (including the section relating to the moulin des Gollies).

Monday, 07 mar 1531, Confessio Michaelis Mayor dez Ballens filii quondam Humberti filiique Petri Mayor alias dou Verney de eodem. Res et possessions... que antiquitus fuerunt Doucete filie Jaquet Soudant deinde vero Anthonii dou Verney dez Ballens et successive Michaelis et Petri dicti Mayor filiorum suorum and recognized by the said Michel and Pierre in the hands of Aymonet Pollens... and acquired through his paternal succession as well as by division “imper” with Pierre and Glaude (see below, they are brothers, sons of the late Jacobus), as well as Anthoine Mayor his condvisors. There is mention on fol. 145 of “alia recognitione antedictorum Michaelis et Petri Mayor *et nepotum suorum* que fuerunt Johannis Soudant dez Mollens”. This passage suggests that the other condvisors, presumably meaning the still living Pierre and Claude, and their deceased brother Antoine, were the nephews of Michel and Pierre du Verney, and that therefore, Jacob should have been another son of the original Antoine du Verney. Also on fol. 145, note property jx pratum Jacobi Monod alias Noblet.

However, the “alia recognition antedictorum Michaelis et Petri Mayor” now appears to be the one on fol. 66 of Fj 5, apparently 24 jul 1496, for “eisdem fratres seu pocius patruus et nepotes predicti confitenti”. This curious designation evidently refers to the preceding reconnaissance, fol. 64, for Petrus et Michael dicti Mayor de Ballen filii quondam Anthonii dou Verney, which was signed by Jacobus Mayor for his uncle Michael Mayor, and by the said Jacobus along with Humbertus his brother, for their father Petrus Mayor. If the construction of this passage were not very precise, the explanation might be that it refers to Michael Mayor and *his* nephews Jacobus and Humbertus, sons of Petrus Mayor, who

would thus be, collectively, “patruus et nepotes”. In this case, this Jacobus would have to be the son of Petrus son of Anthoinius de Verneto.

146v Petrus Mayor

07 mar 1531, Recognitio Petri Mayor filii quondam Jacobi Mayor alias dou Verney dez Ballens facta suo proprio necnon honeste viri Glaudii Mayor clerici eius fratris ac Glaudie eorum neptis filie quondam Anthonii Mayor nominibus. One property fol. 148 jx terram Jacobi Boudat et Johannete eius uxoris filie quondam Nycodi Augyer, de bonis quondam Nycodi de Plathea (this passage possibly ambiguous). Various others need to be studied. The Claude Mayor called clericus in this reconnaissance is apparently the same person called sutor in all the other reconnaissances ! Is this perhaps an error, or had he followed both professions? Since Claude the sutor shares a set of properties with Antoine, but apparently not with Michel or Pierre (unless he is actually Claude the clericus, who does share properties with Pierre), we have to look for a statement in Pierre’s reconnaissance that the same Claude his brother is the owner of an adjacent property that we can identify in the list of the properties of Claude the sutor. There do not seem to be any such properties! Or, are there any properties that Claude the sutor shares with Jacob Mathey that border a property held by Pierre Mayor and his brother Claude the clericus? Or any properties of Antoine that border property of Pierre and his brother Claude the clericus?

Among the provisions of this reconnaissance (fol. 147v), Pierre Mayor pays the cense not only for dimidiam falcatam prati ou Nactet alias en laz Chamberoteyriz supra loz dez Malpraz, juxta partum Jacobi Cuvit senioris quod fuit a Lambert a borea, partum Anthonii filii quondam Nycodi Soudant dez Ballens et plurium aliorum a vento, aquam dez laz Chamberoteyriz a juria, et partum Petri filii quondam Glaudii Bessonson quod fuit ou Rossel a lacu... but also for “certis rebus quod tenet **Glaudius Mayor sutor habitator dez Mollens** de huiusmodi bonis quorum ipse confitens tenetur ferre omnis census annualis vigore division suarum predictarum debet et debere confitetur”. The « division suarum predictarum » is certainly the one described on fol. 147, “ex divisionibus suis imper inter ipsum confitentem atque Michaellem et Anthonium Mayor condivisores suos factis.” Even though the description of the division does not mention Claude Mayor in this instance, it must certainly be the same division described in greater detail on fol. 134, for Antoine Mayor, in that instance the Claude that is mentioned is the one who is the brother of Pierre, though his occupation is not listed.

150v Petrus de Frigidavilla (=de Froideville) (alias Cua de Loup)

Previously de bonis Johanneti Terraulx filii quondam Glaudii Terraulx et dict Jacobi Terraulx ipsius Johanneti nepotis filii quondam Hugoneti Terraulx dez Ballens ... per eisdem Johannetum et Jacobum in manibus Aymoneti Pollens..., and previously by dicti Hugoneti Terraulx et antiquitus Rolete filie quondam Voucherii Soudant uxoris Mermeti de Frigidavilla et deinde dicti Glaudii Terraulx gener Petri de Frigidivilla quondam dictis Terraulx fratribus. Ex legitime successione paterna... One parcel adjacent to Anthonii Mayor quod fuit Johanneti Cygoen. (The most likely explanation is that Petrus and Sulpicius were sons of the “dicti

Jacobum” Terraulx. Claudius Terraulx must have married a daughter of Petrus de Frigidavilla alias Cua de Loup.)

156v Michael Lambert

Tam ex successione sua paterna quem ex divisionibus suis ... inter dictum Philibertum Lambert eius quondam patrem et Humbertum Lambert fratres factis... que fuerunt Michaelis Lambert dez Ballens ipsius confitenti avi paterni filii quondam Petri Lambert... and before that by Johanneti de Prata and ? Johannodi Lausenon and deinde Petri Joli ac Nycodi Terthollet et Peronte eius uxoris.

159 Humbertus Lambert

27 feb 1531, Humbertus Lambert filius quondam Michaelis filiusque quondam Petri Lambert dez Ballens. Previously recognized by said Michael (Aymoneti Pollens), que pridem fuerunt tam Johannodi de Prata quem Johannodi Lansenon.... Philibert was late brother of Humbert, they had made a division. One parcel adjacent to Michaelis Mayor alias douz Verney. Witnesses are “omnibus dez Ballens”!

161 Petrus Bizanson (alias of de Froideville)

28 feb 1531 (note the presence of the witness Stephanus Monod alias Cigoen !). Petrus Besenczon alias de Frigidavilla dez Ballens filius quondam Glaudii Besenczon alias de Frigidavilla filiusque Besoneti de Frigidavilla dez Ballens. Previously recognized by « dicti Glaudii Besenczon patris sui alias per ipsus Gladium suo proprio et Johannis filii quondam Jacobi filiique quondam Hugoneti de Frigidavilla ipsius confitentus avinepotis nominibus facte in manibus quondam Aymoneti Pollens olim commissarii... », and before that by « dicti Hugoneti de Frigidavilla ipsius Glaudii fratris et avipatrem dicti Johannis », and before that by Rolete filie quondam Voucherii dicti Soudan uxoris Mermeti de Frigidavilla. To Petrus « tam ex successione eiusdem Glaudii Besenczon quem ex partagio suo alias inter ipsum confitentis cum Johanne Monnaz et Marmete (?) eiusdem uxore filia quondam dicti Glaudii Besenczon facto... ».

164v Claudius Vuarenchat (=Vuarenchat) de Sancto Prothasio habitatoris dez Ballens facta suo et conjuntorio nomine Stephane eius uxoris ac Jacobi et Suplicii ipsius Stephane fratrum filiorum quondam Johannes Monaz dez Passier et Marie uxor sue filie quondam Glaudii Besenczon dez Ballens nominibus.

The property corresponding to the other half of one described in the next reconnaissance is on fol. 168: En laz Grandmuraz medietatem unius falcate prati jx pratum Nycodi Roguyn et Johannis Lugryn quod fuit Nobilis Glaudii dez Lavignyer et pridem Petri dez Mont a juria et borea, pratum Stephani Monod alias Cygoen et Petri Mayor alias Monod eius nepotism ab huiusmodi divisum et de presentdi feudo a lacu, et pratum Johannis Bonjor que fuit Johannis Costantyn et pratum Stephani Grand alias Cohendoz a vento.

Also, the next property (fol. 168v) relates the next reconnaissance: En Muraz quartam partem duarum falcatarum prati jx pratum Stephani Monod a presenti divisum a borea, pratum Michaelis Mayor etiam ab huiusmodi divisum et de presenti feudo a vento, fluxum cum aque Veronis a lacu, et nemus douz Crest dou Thon Anthonii Mayor olim terram quondam Jaqueti Lambert a juria.

The first two items appear to be divisions of a property recognized 25 apr 1496 by Petrus Mayor junior filius quondam Mondeti Mayor de Ballen (ACV Fj 5, fol. 72) that was purchased by him (?) 12 apr 1457 from Johannes Soudan, "en Muraz unam falquatam prati" jx pratum Nobilis Glaudii de Lavignyer quod fuit Petri de Mont a juria et borea, aquam Veronis a lacu, et pratum Johannis Costantin et dictorum Grand (=Coendoz) a vento. The other halves of these two parcels are found above, fol. 167 ff, in the reconnaissance of Franciscus Monod and his cousins. If there is a separate description for the property "en Grandmuraz" in Fj5, we have not been able to locate it, and so we suppose that it was omitted in error or else that it was considered a part of the property "en Muraz".

A summary of the Mayor and Monod relationships in Fg 52 may be useful at this point:

1. Anthonius Mayor (Anthoine son of Michel Mayor alias du Verney and for Anthoine's brothers Jean and Ottonin, and previously from Michel and Pierre Mayor alias du Verney, brothers)
2. Michael Mayor (Michel fils de Humbert [once called, in error, Huguonnet], fils de Pierre Mayor alias du Verney, and previously from Michel and Pierre Mayor alias du Verney, brothers)
3. Petrus Mayor (Pierre Mayor and his brother Claude, not the Claude who settled at Mollens, but rather, Claude the notary – these are sons of Jacob du Verney, and they have a niece Claude who is daughter of their late brother Anthoine). There is considerable confusion over the identity of the Claude who settled at Mollens. It appears that Jacob du Verney had two sons named Claude Mayor.
4. Franciscus Mayor alias Monod (apparently he was the son of the late François Monod and his wife Jeanne). The late François may be the same man intended in a few places as: “heirs of François and Jean Monod” or “the children of François and Jean Monod”, implying that François and Jean were brothers, and that each had left at least one child, and that they had owned their property jointly. Further, the late Franciscus and Johannes, now clearly identifiable as brothers, since their children were “germanorum” or first cousins, had a late brother Petrus, probably the son of Mondet.
5. Stephanus Monod (=Thivent Monod alias Cigoen, or Etienne Monod and his nephew Pierre Monod, previously from the children of Aymonet Monod and/or from Pierre Monod “junior” who is elsewhere son of Mondet). Some of the property held by Stephanus and his nephew came from (the late) Pierre Mayor junior, evidently not the same person as the Pierre who was the son of Anthonius du Verney. Stephanus was the son of Petrus Cigoen, but his nephew is Petrus son of Claudius Monod; therefore, Stephanus must have married a Monod daughter who was a sister of Claudius. While later terriers say the property was from Pierre Mayor junior, the present terrier says it was from Petrus son of Mondetus Mayor. This is confirmed in the previous terrier Fj 5 (Aymonet Pollens), where on fol. 72 we find the reconnaissance of Petrus Mayor junior filius quondam Mondeti Mayor de Ballens.
6. Jacobus Monod alias Noblet was the son of Petrus Monod, apparently the same one who was the brother of the late Franciscus and Johannes. The use of the alias, and the link with the Noblet family (Mermet Noblet was his guardian) suggests that Petrus Monod had married a Noblet.

Further, groups 4 and 5 owned at least some property jointly, each with a 50% interest. Also, some of the property of groups 1, 2, and 3 was owned jointly (50% interest) with Claude Mayor, sutor of Ballens, who now lived in Mollens, and whose corresponding reconnaissance is combined with that of his father-in-law Jacob Mathey alias dez Ballens.
