Partial analysis (volume has no index):

Arms of Michel de Savoie, barred, surmounted by a prior's hat.

1 Extenta demanii homagiorum que recognicionum censuum reddituum etc., for the priory of Romanimonasterii ordinis clugniacensis, in the diocese of Lausanne and pertaining to the villages of Mollens, Biroulaz (Berolle), Monrichier (Montricher), Villarboson, and Pampignie.

Introduction

“Duplum antique recognitionis hominum de Mollens”:

Copy of reconnaissance by inhabitants of Mollens for the priory, executed at Lausanne, feria tertia post octabas purificationis beate Marie virginis, 1391 (?). The inhabitants thus recognizing their obligations for themselves and their heirs as “imperpetuum homines talliabiles Religiosorum virorum prioris et conventus Romanimonasterii” were: “Nos Raymondus dictus Palaz, Huguetus dictus Codrivens, Raymondus filius Wibreti, Nicolaus filius A la coite (elsewhere: A la Coindé, possibly the ancestors of the Coendoz family), Jacobus frater eius, Reynauldus de Vallorbes, Aymo Parvus, Petrus filius alier Bertholdus de Vallorbes, Johannes dictus Morel, Huguetus et Petrus fratres filii Johannis Bastar, et Petrus de Gollies de Mollens.”

3 « Double d'une provision faite par le conte de Namur qui per lors estoit Seigneur de Wau (=Vaud) à cause de ladite Juridicion de Mollens » (in French)

« Guillaume Conte de Namur et Sire de Wau à noz Amée et fiaulx Guillaume de Billens Chastellain de Mont et de Rolle et Thobie dou Sollier Chastellain de Morge, salut et dilection. Comme Religieuses personnes ly priour et ly couvent de Romainmostier qui sont en nostre saulve garde se doellent et complaignent que aulcungs des officiers et messaiges de Noble homme Nochier (=notre cher) Seigneur Monseigneur Loy de Savoe (=de Savoie) jadis de bonne mémoire Seigneur de Waud leur ayent tomber (?) et occuper la seignorie que il maintienent avoir en la ville de Mollens et afferment yce (=iceluy, celà) estre fait sans cause de raison, nous vous mandons et commectons et ambodeux (=vous deux) ensemble que vous enqueres diligemment la verité de ces chouses tam pour nous comme pour eulx, et ce fait, que vous reportes votre enquete à Noz amez et fiaulx Monsieur Jehan de Blonay notre ballyf de Vuau et Monsieur Guillaume de Dompierre chastellain de Romont au quelx Nous en avons mandé notre volenté, per le tesmoing de ces presentes scellées de nostre seel. Données à Namur le xxvi jour de May l'an de grace Mil CCC cinquante et six (25 may 1356). »

3v Response to the above from Franciscus dominus de Sarrata, Miles, Ballivus Vuaudi, 27 jan 1358, followed by transcript of a settlement of dispute between the priory and Johannes son of the late Nycolay de Mont regarding their claims at Mollens, 05 oct 1285?. (Also named, Girard, brother of Johannes de Mont. Girard and Johannes died about 1310. Their father died about 1269.) Subscribed by Franciscus de Sarrata at Moudon, 07 feb 1358. (François de la Sarra, Bailli de Vaud, died in 1360.)

6 Quictancio facta de molendino, July 1257? “Ego Nicolaus dictus de Mont Miles”, regarding controversy with the priory over the mill that the prior had constructed between the villages of Ballens and Mollens “supra fluvium qui dicitur ly Veyron”. Mentions his sons Johannes and Girardus.

Mentions property of Stephani dicti de Bieriz (=de Bière) militis between the mill and the “domum leprosorum de Gollies”.

6v Exchange of certain property near the mill of Gollies, Monday after the feast of St. Luke, 1285, between Johannes de Mont domicellus filius quondam Nicolay de Mont militis, and the priory.

7 Demanium, description of the property held by the priory at Mollens. Marginal notation in Latin, partly cut off during binding, relates to confiscation of this property by Bern in 1556. Mentions pratum de Reuers (pratum eis Moennoz) adjacent to pratum of Petri Mayor de feudo N. Glaudii de Lavignye quod fuit N. de Mont. Mentions mill de Gollies on the Veyron, with certain lands that were previously held by Girarda filia Joheneti Davoyr (see below, fol. 57). The properties for which the priory claims the “dîme” extend into Berolle as well.

Thus, the parties who signed were : (for Michael Mayor), Jacobus Mayor his nephew ; (and for Petrus Mayor), his sons Jacobus and Humbertus.

66v « Eisdem fratres seu pocius patruus et nepotes predicti confitenti », same date as previous item (but which of the two dates is meant ?). (Translation : “These brothers or rather the paternal uncle and nephews of the said parties” / « Lesdits frères ou plutôt les oncle paternel et neveux des dits confessants ». They are not identified explicitly in this reconnaissance, but in the one that precedes it, the nephews might be Jacobus and Humbertus, sons of Petrus and thus nephews of Michael. There is a possibility that the construction was careless, and that the indended parties are Michael Mayor and his nephews Jacobus and Humbertus, who are thus “patruus et nepotes”. It may be possible to identify the properties ascribed to these parties in the succeeding terrier of Franciscus Grossi, Fg 52, and thus learn

what a later generation had to say about them.) ... de bonis et recognicione Johannis Soudant ex acquisitionem per ipsos vel dicti patrum factis. (Thus, purchased from Johannes Soudan by the father of the said paternal uncle ? If the paternal uncle in question was Michael, then the father was Anthonius Mayor alias du Verneto.)

The preceding item, along with what appears to be an adjoining parcel « en Grandmuraz » that should probably have been included in this reconnaissance, are found in Fg 52 (fol. 167 ff and 170 ff) divided between Stephanus Cigoen alias Monod and his nephew Petrus son of Claudius Mayor alias Monod, and Franciscus Mayor/Monod and his cousins, apparently grandchildren of the present Petrus Mayor junior.
