

Fj 8 Abbaye du Lac de Joux 1522 by Johannes Maioris

The description of this terrier at the ACV says that folios 151-283, concerning Ballens, have been removed, as well as folios 296-302. This appears to be a misprint, the figure 151 should read 251, as the section for Ballens should begin at folio 252, according to the index.

The notary Jean Mayor was the son of Aymonet Pollens, who compiled the previous terrier Fj 5. The family was originally Besson of Lausanne, with two aliases, Mayor and Pollens. The next terrier in the series is Fj 15, by Abel son of Jean Mayor, 1552-1564, from which the section for Ballens has also been removed!

02 may 1525, Stephanus filius quondam Francisci Cuvit de Mollens, previously by Humbert Cordey and before that by Johannes Lambert alias Curto. (Reference to Humbert Cordey is probably an error, since each of the three sons of the late Franciscus Cuvit seems to have held 1/3 of the same property, that the reconnaissances for the other two brothers, and the later reconnaissances in Fj 15 all attribute to Mermet Cordey, not Humbert Cordey.)

**291v Claudius Cuvit**

02 may 1525, Claudius Cuvit filius quondam Francisci Cuvit de Mollens, previously by Mermet Cordey and before that by Johannes Lambert alias Curto.

**293 Jacobus Cuvit**

02 may 1525, Jacobus Cuvit filius quondam Francisci Cuvit de Mollens, previously by Mermet Cordey and before that by Johannes Lambert.

**294 Johannes et Franciscus Quiquiz de Sancto Liberio**

(the folio on which the date should have appeared has been cut out, along with the folios covering Bière and Montricher.) – Johannes et Franciscus Quiquiz de Sancto Liberio, unum morcellum prati situm in confine de Ballen, previously (Aymonet Pollens) by Stephanus Vyonet et Anthonius his son
