This volume is an unsigned copy or extract of reconnaissances from another volume. The title of each reconnaissance notes a folio number where the original reconnaissance would be found. That volume, whatever it was, had at least 190 folios, but that source has not been further identified, apart from the fact that the original reconnaissances were compiled by Guiliermus Berardi and finalized after 1504 by his son-in-law Mermetus Badelli.

Unusually, P de Mestral (I) 1505 has several later endpapers or cover sheets, trimmed in such a way that text at the top and bottom has been removed, in a very clear hand that uses the æ ligature, indicating the scribe's familiarity with Classical Latin (but not extending to the classical spelling of names, such as Joannes). These pages, unnumbered, might have come from a reconnaissance or quernet by the an unidentified noble subject to the Count of Gruyère. Unfortunately, the inventory of the ACV does not account for these pages, and their placement is not clear from the available photographs.

The first numbered folio (original Roman numerals, as well as later Arabic numerals) is a typical but untitled introduction to a terrier, in the words of Guiliermus Berardi, ending at the bottom of fol. 3, lacking a date. On fol. 3v, the introductory text is now in the words of Mermetus Badelli, son-in-law of Guiliermus Berardi, explaining that he is the proper custodian of the protocols of Berardi and has continued the project, again without a date. At the bottom of fol. 3v, this is followed by a copy of the commission by Aymo de Montefalcone, bishop of Lausanne, to Mermetus Badelli, giving him custody of the protocols of Berardi, and giving him the commission to finalize the project, dated 16 aug 1504. At this point, fol. 4v, there is a title (in ordinary script), Endominum quod habet prefatus dominus Rupiffortis et condominus Albone in villa Morgie et ibi circa ad causam domus sue de Morgiæ. The "endominium" continues to fol. 6, followed immediately on that folio by the first individual reconnaissances, which generally lack the closing formalities.

Some items are accompanied by extensive marginal notations in a different hand, often incompletely legible due to erosion of the outer margins or partially hidden in the binding. The content of these notations includes later tenants and some folio citations, several dated in 1522. P de Mestral (I) 1511, compiled by Louis Challet, with dates 1522-1526, may be the successor to the present volume.



Endpapers: The five unnumbered sides are images 6-10, not noted in the inventory of the ACV. Their correct order is not obvious. With careful inspection of the parts of the edges of the images, the order seems to be:

Inside the front cover, inverted:

First folio, image 6 (originally a recto), apparently pasted inside the front cover.

(Content: part of the introduction of a quernet by a *dominus recognoscens*, to the *dominus comes*, at Apples, first censier Petrus Villard de Apples.)

Second folio, image 10 (originally the verso of image 7), image 7 (originally the recto of image 10).

Followed by proper flyleaf (image 11), with modern pencil inscription P de Mestral 1505, then one more blank folio, followed by the original repertorium (2 folios, images 152-154).

Inside the back cover, inverted:

Last folio, image 9 (originally a recto), apparently pasted inside the back cover.

(Content: parcels held by Franciscus Cuissins, mention of heirs of Petrus Billiard.)

Next to last folio, image 8 (originally a recto), the other side either inaccessible or not photographed, but some writing showing faintly through the paper.

Preceded apparently by another blank folio, not photographed.
