

AEF Grosses Estavayer 125, for Girardus de Illens, domicellus, commissaire Johannes Chuard de Cugie, 1425-1439, and continued by Petrus Mayor and others, 1450-1479.

Fols. 1-59 were compiled, with one exception, by Johannes Chuar (by the 16th Century, this name was almost always spelled Chuard), all for Noble Girard d'Illens, with dates ranging from 1425 to 1439. Then, beginning at fol. 59v, the reconnaissances are in favor of his son Pierre d'Illens, and recorded by Petrus Mayor, 1450-1460, followed by a few later reconnaissances recorded by other notaries. At the end, there are a few pages that appear to be fragments of later records, one dated 1488.

While there is an index, the script in that section is very messy. The main text is far more legible, though not without problems. The text consists mainly of unusually short, concise statements that a particular individual acknowledges that he owes Girard d'Illens a cense for a particular property and will pay him in perpetuity on a certain day of the year, under pain of double damages. Most of the other legalistic sections and phrases of the period are omitted. There may be multiple short reconnaissances for the same person on the same date, not listed separately here. Most of the texts in the hand of Petrus Mayor are also quite short.

42v ~~Uldrieta filia relict~~a (the word filia is actually lined out twice, because it was an error in the original text, then the entire passage was replaced with what follows) Contessa filia quondam Perrodi Baquin ~~relict~~~~a filia~~~~que quondam Perrodi Grangie~~ (this passage, lined out, and relict a doubly lined out, referred to Uldrieta in the original text, and something indistinct was added later above the line, perhaps saying “with the approval of the husband of the said Contessa”), property at Sasel, 11 mar 1426, these two items lacking the signature and paraphe of the commissaire.

[relationship omitted!] dictis Johanneti ? ... uxor quondam Petri de Furno ? de Cugie in manibus quondam Johannis Chuard clerici Cuagiaci tunc commissarii quondam Nobilis Girardi de Illens (thus presumably referring back to a previous item in this terrier), 08 aug 1472, but with a different signature and paraphe, not identified. (On fol. 67v, the same signature and paraphe are somewhat clearer, the name may be Petrus Faveteir or Faneteir?) (The prior reconnaissance is probably the one found on fol. 7, above, Jaqueta Joliaz uxor Petri de Furno morans apus Cugie with approval of her husband, 25 nov 1425.)

73v Three lines, very indistinct, mentioning Jaquetus Drochat, Sunday after Christmas?, year not clear, remainder of page blank.
