

ACV C IX b 1434 Prieuré de Lutry, fragment of a terrier, commissaire Petrus Villiencii burgensis Burgi Sancti Mauricii Tharentaisensis diocesis

The fragment is in reasonably good condition, although the script is messy. There are marginal references to folio numbers in some other volume or volumes. While the inventory of the ACV indicates the fragment consists of fols. 120-132, the envelope was found also to contain another fragment in a different hand, fols. 147-150, apparently parts of one or more reconnaissances for Petrus de Ogo, together with a loose folio, part of a *repertorium licterarum cure Lustriaci*, a list of numbered documents, lacking dates. Both the fragment with fols. 147-150 and the loose repertorium are labeled in blue pencil, “1320-1450”, and on fol. 147, “Lutry”. There is no internal evidence to connect them with the terrier of Villiencii, and no additional archival notations to suggest that they are misfiled. Their correct placement in the collections of the ACV is unknown.



120 Continuation of a reconnaissance for an unknown reconnaissant and his brother Guilliernus, lacks complete date and signature, but apparently in 1490.

121 Nobilis et Potens Humbertus Cerjat dominus de Combremont le Petit, 20 may 1487, de bonis que quondam fuerunt Ansermodi de Chanrenaux (=Champrenaux) domicelli de Espesses hominis ligii predecessorum prefati domini commandatarii (inserted by reference mark: deinde fuerunt Anthonii Maliardo de Rota ex empto per me facto a Humberto Malliardo filio quondam dicti Anthonii), et me tenere sub dicto homagio ligio morcellum vinee subscriptum (inserted by reference mark: alias Venerabili viro Domino Johanni de Vuilliens tunc dicti prioratus prioris) in manibus Petri de Quercu notarii quondam et commissarii ipsius prioratus recognitis. Also, de bonis alias Venerabili viro Domino Johanni de Vuilliens quondam dicti prioratus prioris in manibus Petri de Quercu notarii Lustriaci et dicti prioratus commissarii per Peronetum Girardi de Espesses quondam hominis dicti prioratus talliabilis ad misericordiam et manus mortue condicione recognitis, deinde affranchiatis liberatis et manum missum prout de affranchiamento constat et apparet instrumento inde confecto, receptoque, signato per Providum virum Humbertum de Mediavilla notarium Lausanne per dictos affranchiatorum et manum missorum in capellano ? ipsius prioratus tunc capitullantes et dicte ... ad sonnum campane congregatos et constitutos capitullantesque et propterea capellan... tenentes, datum die xxiiii mensis Maii anno domini m^o iiii^clxiiii^{to} (24 may 1464), laudato deinde auctoritazato et confirmato per reverendum abatem insignis abacie Savigniacensis superiorem dicti prioratus et conventus eiusdem prout constat et apparet de ratificatione lictera inde confecta et laudata per prefatum dominum abatem Savigniaci eidem instrumento affranchiamenti annexa sigillataque sigillo dicti domini abatis ibidem exhibita..., no signature but otherwise apparently complete. (Margin: Libro per *p* f[olio] xiiii^{xx}xvi, and near the end, another notation, Libro per *p* f[olio] xiiii^{xx}ix, referring to the

document cited in the text with a date of 24 may 1464. The surviving “affranchissements” are in ACV Ad 14, a small volume originally without foliation, with irregular modern pagination extending only to p. 35. Clearly, there was once another, much larger volume of “affranchissements” recorded by Humbertus de Mediavilla.)

123 Mermetus Eymeri parrochie Sancti Simphoriani de Chebres, 15 may 1489, Mermetus Eymery de Ripa parrochie Sancti Simphorii, de bonis Hudrisodi Begnym ? de Espesses, deinde fuerunt Nycodi du Bos ex tradicionem dotali michi facte per dictum Nycodum du Bos dudum recognitis sub jugo et servitute tallie ad misericordiam et manus mortue condicione bone memorie predicto Domino Johanni de Vuilliens tunc priore dicti prioratus in manibus Petri de Quercu notarii Lustriaci recognitis per predictum Hudrisodum Begnym quondam hominis talliabilis ad misericordiam, deinde afranchiatis liberatis et manum missis per bone memorie Dominum Guigonem de Rocheta sedis apostolice prothonotarium et dicti prioratus administratorem perpetuum per conventum ipsius prioratus prout constat et apparet instrumento inde confecto receptoque et signato per predictum Humbertum de Mediavilla notarium Lausanne per dictos affranchiatores et manum missores in capelo dicti prioratus tunc capitullantes et dicto capelo ad sonnum campane congregatos et constitutos capitullantesque et propterea capellum tenentes die xxiiii mensis Maii anno domini mo iii^c lxiiii laudatoque deinde autoritate et confirmato per reverendum abatem insignis abatie Savigniacensis superiorem dicti prioratus et conventus eiusdem prout constat et apparet de ratificatione lictera inde confecta et laudata per prefatum dominum abatem Saviaci eidem instrumento affranchiati annexa sigillataque sigillo ipsius domini abatis ibidem exhibita, no signature. Followed by later notation, largely illegible but dated die Martis ante Dominiam de Occulli 1503.

124 Nobilis Vuilliermus David de Friburgo domicellus, die Mercurii post Purificationem Domine Nostre 02 feb 1489 Style of the Annunciation, Vuilliermus David burgensis Friburgo, de bonis alia prefato Fratri Johannis de Vuilliens tunc dicti prioratus priore in manibus predictis per dictum Hudrisodi Begnym recognitis, deinde affranchiatis liberatis et manum missas per dictum Dominum Guigonem de Rocheta tunc dicti prioratus administratorem perpetuum et per conventum ipsius prioratus prout constat et apparet instrumento inde recepto et signato per dictos affranchiatorum in capelo ipsius prioratus tunc capitullantes et dicto capelo ad sonnum campane congregatos et constitutos prout supra, datum die et anno premissis..., not signed.

125v Francesia relicta Johannis Cagniard ? d’Espesses, lacks complete date, ad opus prefati Reverendi in Christo Patris Domini Benedicti de Monteferrando Dei et Apostolice sedis gracie Lausannensis episcopi ... and representing the priory of Lutry, reconnaissance based on a previous one per Johannem Cagniard naturalem Johannis Parvem ? de Espesses in manibus dicti Petri de Quercu..., citing also an affranchisement recorded by Humbertus de Mediavilla dated 24 may 1464...

126v Vuilliermus Ramus de Ruex (=Riex), lacks date, reconnaissance, de bonis Symonis Bersier ? de Espesses ex empto facto a heredibus dicti Symonis.

127v Nobiles viri Rodulphus et Anthonius filii quondam Nobilis Henrici de Praromant de Friburgo, 10 jun 1487, de bonis Thome Bernier quondam homini talliabilis..., ex empto predecessores nostros inde facto a heredibus Jaqueti Bernier ? , referring to a previous

reconnaissance by Thomas Bernier recorded by Petrus de Quercu, and an affranchisement recorded by Humbertus de Mediavilla dated 24 may 1464.

129v Vulliermus filius quondam Johannis Ramus de Riez, 05 jun 1490 ? (but with a notation in the bottom margin, Laudatum est xiii maii lxxxvii), de bonis Symonis Bersier de Espesses ex empto per patrem meum facto a Johanne Michoz de eodem, later recognized by the said Symon, recorded by Petrus de Quercu, and citing affranchisement of 24 may 1464 recorded by Petrus de Mediavilla.

130v Petrus filius quondam Petri Berlens parrochie de Crepillioz mandamenti de Oron, 10 jul 1490, Petrus filius quondam Petri Berlens de Oron parrochie de Crepillioz, de bonis et confessione Jaquerii et Mermeti de Crousaz de Chebre parrochie Sancti Simphoriani, that "confessio" recorded by Petrus de Quercu.

131v Jordana filia quondam Johannis Ruchinet du Bos supra Espesses uxorque Anthonii Pollat de Melduno, 25 ? jun 1490, de bonis alias per Rodulphum du Bos, recorded by Petrus de Quercu, citing affranchisement of 24 may 1464 recorded by Humbertus de Mediavilla.

132v (Title only) Nobilis et Potens vir Dominus Anthonius de Menthone baron domini Menthonis et Castellii Sancti Dionisii.

147 Continuation of a reconnaissance for Perrodus de Ogo, date left blank at the end.

149 Another item for Dictus Perrodus de Ogo, continuing to fol. 150v, without closing formalities or date.
