

ACV FL 11 Reconnaissances at Bellerive and Villars-le-Grand copied for Estienne de Wyttembach, 1552, commissaire Petrus de Molendino, from earlier sources circa 1506-1529.

The inventory of the ACV describes this item as an envelope containing two “cahiers” and one “registre”, identified respectively as sections A (12 folios), B (27 folios), and C (110 folios plus an index). We have not yet established that the three sections actually belong together, but they all involve Noble Nicolas Wyttenbach (or in fact, his son Estienne) “à cause du fief de St-Maurice rière Bellerive” or (fols. 80-107 of section C) his holdings derived from the former fief of the charitable hospital of Avenches. This item was previously only available on microfilm. Now that it has been digitized, a much better assessment is possible. At least the A section seems to have been compiled by Petrus de Molendino, attested by his signature and paraphe.



Cover : indistinct inscriptions, but including in the center a notation, “factum des Gachet de Payerne fo. xlviiii” ; and at the bottom in a clear and apparently later ink, “Avenches”. The cover, apparently now enclosing but not necessarily attached to all sections of this “terrier”, proves to be a folded parchment, of which the nearly blank verso is exposed. Two slits and a ribbon of parchment are visible at the bottom, where a seal was once attached. Two ranks of thread are visible on the outside surface, by which the cover it attached to some part of the contents, likely the C section. This cover was originally a separate document, and the lack of a formal title on the exposed verso indicates its use in this way must have been a much later development. However, as there is no “factum” for the Gachet of Payerne in this volume, we surmise that the cover was at some point used for some other volume.

The inside of the cover, originally the recto of the parchment serving this purpose, concerns a debt or loan owed by Petrus Cristinaz nunc residens in Bella Rippa to Marguereta relicta quondam Roleti de Tombex dicti loci de Bella Rippa, 31 may 1451, originally recorded by Jaquetus Buschynel de Bella Rippa, and copied after his death by Ludovicus de Tretorens de Melduno. The parties are mentioned many times in the course of the actual contents of FL 11, as predecessors to the tenants of many properties that were enumerated in the early 16th Century, but the document concerns only a financial obligation and not any specific properties or fiefs that would connect it directly to present terrier.

The first “cahier”, designated “A” by the ACV, was originally unnumbered. Modern folio numbers were added for the digitization project, beginning with fol. A1. The “cahier” does not appear to be attached to the cover, and its dimensions are taller and narrower than the cover. The contents consist of brief listings of tenants and the amounts that are owed, with various marginal

notations, including a glyph that appears to be \mathfrak{B} or perhaps \mathfrak{B} , signifying (seemingly explicit on fol. A1v) *solvit* (“paid”). As almost all items are preceded by two such glyphs, it is possible the text was used as a checklist for recording payments received during two years. Other notations refer to the need for additional documentation, or that payment was made in 1554, or that payments were shared with other parties, etc. There are also a few marginal notations indicating that an “extract” (of the underlying reconnaissance) is to be found on another folio: for example, on fol. A4, we find “Extractu folio xlix”, and indeed, on fol. C49, we find the appropriate reconnaissance for Marie, femme de Jehan Christina, bearing the impossible date of 29 feb 1526. While the date must be an error, it is clear that that the A section was to be used together with the C section.

This section was also originally unnumbered. Modern foliation was supplied by the ACV for the digitization project.

“C” section: reconnaissances for Nycolas de Witenbach de Bienne burgensis Berne, 1552. This section was originally numbered (Roman numerals), and the modern foliation by the ACV follows the original.

Noble Pierre du Moullin seigneur de Treytorens fait par le procureur de Noble Anthoine Pavilliard à cause de son fied de Saint Maurys des acquis faitz de Glaude filz de Pierre Tissot demourant en Tyeylle, various properties, citing documents of 17 jan 1547 (the original reconnaissances) and 18 may 1548 (the lod or confirmation), recorded by Discret Pierre Richard. The implication is that the specific properties in this short transaction were purchased separately, not as part of the acquisition of the rest of the fief.

C1v Apparently an index of the C section, with entries from fols. 1-67. However, the index entry for folio 1 should actually be folio 2! It is not clear whether there was originally another index folio covering the remainder of the C section, which extends at least to fol. 107.
