

ACV Af 3 Droicts, Tiltres, et Hommages for Humbert de Thoyrier, in the Barony of Aubonne, and for Guillaume and Humbert Allamand, 1275-1344.

The cover of this volume bears an inscription in French, *Registre vieux des fiedz nobles, des vassals, et d'aultres tenants fiedz nobles de la baronnie et seigneurie d'Aulbonne*. However, there is also a subtitle in the same hand, *Fiedz Nobles*, and a large numeral **I**, suggesting this may in fact be only the first volume or section of a larger compilation. There is also an old label attached at the bottom of the cover (the exact placement is not very clear in the digitized images), also in French: *fiefs nobles, hommages et vassaux* / (second line possibly added later, in a smaller hand) *du seigneur d'Aubonne ... 1287, 1322, 1375, 1230 (?) / par Fonjaleti et autres N^o. 441*. Exactly which of the Fonjalleti family of notaries is intended here is not known; they do not seem to be mentioned in the text.

In fact, the dates cover a wide range, and the commissaires or notaries who created them are generally not named. Some items also bear marginal notations indicating later tenants, although only a few of those seem informative. Other marginalia are simply labels, in French, to aid in finding some of the more significant rights and properties.

The repertorium, at the beginning of the volume, also bears the number *441*. It covers entries only as far as fol. 16, ending with an item for Stephanus de Mont, and in fact, the character of the material in the remainder of the volume that follows, fols. 17-24v, changes to a series of "Items" rather than the usual extracts, this section evidently added after the preparation of the repertorium.

While Af 2 appears to be a copy of Af 1, from a period where several folios of the latter that are now lost still existed, Af 3 appears to be a partial copy of some of the same material, but with the interesting difference that it provides an exact date for several items from Af 1 and Af 2 where only the month and year were specified. Af 3 is thus likely an independent copy from one or more sources from which Af 1 was compiled. Af 3 also sometimes includes additional information about the reconnaissances.

Because of the complex relationships among Af 1, Af 2, and Af 3, a concordance has been prepared as a separate document.



1 Johannes condominus de Albona, 06 aug 1322, reconnaissance for Nobilis Agnes de Villariis domina de Albona, adding several parcels to a previous reconnaissance not described in detail, commissaire not named, but witnesses Dominus Johannes de Rossellione, Vulliermus de

Greysiaco, Johannes de Monte, Richardus et Stephanus de Montibus, et Roletus de Lavignie domicellus.

1 Johannes filius quondam Dominus Nycolai de Monte, 03 may 1291, reconnaissance for Humbertus dominus de Thoyry et de Villario, videlicet avoyriam quam predecessores ipsius Johannis tenerunt et habuerunt et ipse Johannes habet et tenet in villa et territorio de Mollens et in hominibus existentibus in ipsis. Item, furnum de Mollens... Also various other rights, including the decime (plural) de Ballens, also noting that this does not include three previous hommages to the dominus de Cossonay, Johannes de Pringins, et the religious of the house of Romanis Monasterii, notary not named. Note the the avoeria in this instance was subject to Humbertus de Thoyry.

1v Stephanus filius quondam Johannis de Monte domicellus, tercio Ydus Marcii 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi dominus de Albona, naming also Girardus brother of Stephanus, holdings in Mollens, excluding an abbergement held by Huguetus Croysiez de Mollens; also in the territories of Bayoes and Coudrey, a mill at Aubonne, various other small properties, notary not named.

2 Jaquetus Mistralis filius quondam dicti Estevenins de Albona, tercio Ydus Marcii 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi dominus de Albona, many properties, including some at Gimel.

2v Richardus filius Ansermi Mistralis de Albona, xiii Kalendas Februarii 1303, reconnaissance for Nobilis Amedeus de Vilariis, the rights to the proceeds of the mistralia of the city of Aubonne, some history not clearly legible.

3 Johannes filius quondam Vulliermi de Salice burgensis de Albone, in Vigilia Conversionis Sancti Pauli 1323, reconnaissance for Guiliermus Alamandi et Agnes de Villariis eius uxor domini de Albona.

3 Petrus Peler de Yens, 02 ? apr 1304, reconnaissance for Nobilis Amedeus de Vilariis, excluding another homage already sworn to the Dominus Vulflens lu Chastel, mention also approval of Nycolaus, brother of Amedeus, and including two men subject to this fief living ou Grasso, one called Raymondus, and the other Rodolphus.

3v Johannes de Lavignier filius quondam Nycolay de Lavignier domicellus, 07 jul 1295, reconnaissance to Humbertus de Toyry et de Villar, various properties.

4 Rodolphus de Lavignier domicellus, die Martis in Vigilia Sancti Pauli 1324 (the year clearly written, but in Af 1 and Af 2, it is 1323), reconnaissance for Nobilis Humbertus Alamandi et Agnes de Vilariis eius uxor domini de Albona, mention Girardus brother of Rodolphus, several properties. (Af 1, fol. 1; Af 2, fol. 6)

4 Johannes Davy (title: Johannes David) burgensis Albone, 06 Idus Junii 1291, reconnaissance for Humbertus de Thory et de Vilar, many properties. (Af 1, fol. 1v, Af 2, fol. 6v)

4v Eballus dominus de Monte, December 1278, reconnaissance for Humbertus dominus de Thory et Villar, various properties, excluding leases to Stephanus dou Terraux and various others, these exclusions and other names poorly legible and possibly of interest.

5 Domina Henrieta domina de Serrata, die Martis in Vigilia Absencionis Beate Marie Virginis 1314, complicated text.

5v Richardus filius quondam Illustris Johannes dominus de Vouflens lo Chastel miles, July 1324, reconnaissance.

6 Girardus de Pysi domicellus, die Martis in Vigilia Conversionis Sancti Pauli 1324, reconnaissance for Guillermus Alamandi et Agnes de Vilariis eius uxor.

6 Vulliermus Sescalli Lausanne, reconnaissance for Humbertus de Thory et de Villar, die post Martis ante ante Anunciacionem (text uncertain and possibly altered) Beate Marie 1287, for censes owed by various individuals. (Af 1, fol. 2; Af 2, fol. 11)

6v Dominus Vulliermus Dapifer, May 1295, reconnaissance for Nobilis Humbertus dominus de Thory et de Villars, at Corsier supra Lustriacum. Followed by notation in the same hand:

Item, est vidimus licere predictae de homagio dicti Domini Vuilliermi confitentis ? manu Johannis de Sancto Libero clerici sub data die Mercurii post festum Sancti Jacobi 1339. (Af 1, fol. 2, where the date is apparently May 1291; Af 2, fol. 11v)

7 Dominus Jacobus dominus de Monrichier, die Veneris post Purificationem Beate Marie Virginis 1275, reconnaissance for Humbertus de Thory et de Villars. (Af 1, fol. 2; Af 2, fol. 12)

7 Vuillierumus de Senaclens (=Senarclens) domicellus filius quondam Domini Johannis de Senaclens militis, July 1299, reconnaissance for Humbertus de Thory. (Af 1, fol. 2v; Af 2, fol. 12v, and duplicates elsewhere in this series)

7 Johannes de Vaut ? domicellus, 06 sep 1301, reconnaissance for Amedeus filius quondam Humbertus de Thorie. (Af 1, fol. 2v; Af 2, fol. 12v)

7 Dominus Hugo de Mornay miles, iiii ? Ydus Aprilis 1317, reconnaissance for Agnes de Vilariis. (Af 1, fol. 2v; Af 2, fol. 13)

7v Hugo filius quondam Nycolay burgensis Albone, 06 jun 1319, reconnaissance for Guillermus Alamandi and his wife Agnes de Vilariis. (Af 1, fol. 3; Af 2, vol. 13v)

7v Dominus Johannes Salterii de Lausana, die Lune post festum Inventionis Sancte Crucis 1319, reconnaissance for Guillermus Alamandi et Agnes de Vilariis eius uxor. (Af 1, fol. 3v; Af 2, fol. 15)

8 Stephanus filius quondam Girardi de Lusserii (title: Lussier) burgensis Albone, iiii Ydus Junii 1322, reconnaissance for Guiliermus Alamandi and Agnes his wife. (Af 1, fol. 5; Af 2, fol. 19v)

8 Franciscus dominus de Nerniaco, die Lune in Crastina Trinitatis 1302, reconnaissance for Amedeus de Villariis. (Af 1, fol. 5; Af 2, fol. 19v)

8 Henricus de Chablier filius quondam Guygoneti de Chablier domicellus dictus de Moyrier, die Mercury ante festum Beati Balnabe Apostoli 1305, reconnaissance for Amedeus de Villariis, properties and unnamed censiers at Gimel and elsewhere. (Af 1, fol. 5v; Af 2, fol. 21)

8v Johannes filius quondam Humberti de Albona, 11 sep 1278, reconnaissance for Humbertus dominus de Thoyris et de Vilar. (Af 1, fol. 10v; Af 2, fol. 27; see also fol. 21v, below)

8v Gurricus dominus de Albona ex una parte et Johannes filius Stephani de Pissy, Humbertus et Petrus fratres sui ex altera, 1306, no day or month listed, concordium, quod unus dictorum fratrum, scilicet Humbertus, sint et remaneat homo dicti Gurryci, various conditions, not entirely legible. While the date in this manuscript is very clear, Anno domini m^o ccc^o vi^o, there is no mention of the seigneurs or prominent nobles of that period. Instead, we think Gurricus dominus de Albona is in fact Guerricus de Albona, from the previous century, and the date thus incorrect or defective. Among other possibilities, the date may be that of a vidimus (copy) rather than the date of the original concordium. (Af 1, fol. 9v, where the item is clearly stated to be a copy, the original dated in 1234. The agreement, here reduced to only 12 lines, also matches the description of an item on the inserted list on fol. “40a” in Af 1, where the date is given as 1234. In Af 2, the long version of this item is clearly the famous “Franchises of Aubonne”.)

9 Stephanus filius Ansermi Petry de Albona, iii Ydus Marcii 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus dominus de Albona, many parcels described, especially in the vicinity of Trevillins.

10 Petrus dominus Montisricherii, die Martis ante festum Beati Vicencii 1338, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi, based on a previous reconnaissance by Jacobus pater dicti Petri et alii predecessores sui.

10 Nobilis Johannes de Senaclens (=Senarclens) filius quondam Jæq Jacobi de Senaclens domicellus, 19 mar 1335, reconnaissance for Nobilis Humbertus Alamandi dominus Albone, citing a previous reconnaissance but not including its date.

10v Johannes filius quondam Girardi de Pissy domicelli, 19 mar 1335 (anno et die quibus supra), reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi, at Gimel and St. Oyens, including homines suos de Bugiez Milon.

10v Johanneta filia quondam Johannis Humberti burgensis Albone, 19 mar 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi dominus Albone, based on a previous reconnaissance by her father, and mentioning her sister Alexia.

11 Rychardus filius quondam Vulliermy de Yens domicellus, ix Kalendas Decembris 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamande dominus de Albona, pro rebus Aymonis de Aples domicelli cognati dicti Rychardi at Aubonne, many parcels described in detail, including one adjacent to the heirs of **Jaquetus Lovat** (top of fol. 11v).

12 Dominus Rychardus dominis Vulflens, 20 mar 1335, reconnaissance for Dominus Humbertus Allamandi dominus Albone, excepta fidelitate et homagia Domini Ludovici de Salbaudia.

12 Hugoninus dominus de Vulflens ly Chastel, iii Ydus Augusti 1339, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi dominus Albone, based on previous reconnaissance by Rychardus pater ipsius Hugonini to the said Humbertus, including unnamed homines.

12v Jaqueta relicta Percivally de Sancto Eugendo de Roteris filia quondam Vulliermi de Sancto Eugendo domicelli, iii Kalendas Junii 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi dominus Albone.

13 Jaqueta filia quondam Jaquete relicte Percivalli de Sancto Eugendo de Roteris domicelli uxorque Petry Sutoris de Gymel de mandato et auctoritate dicti Petry martyti sui, xviii Kalendas Februarii 1344, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi domini Albone.

13v Vulliermus filius quondam Domini Stephani de Balmis militis, 20 mar 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi domini Albone.

13v Dominus Petrus de Gumoyens miles, 20 mar 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi domini Albone.

14 Vulliermus nuctritus quondam Petry de Yens domicelli, xii Kalendas Aprilis 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi domini Albone.

14 Stephanus[,] dominus P. de Gumoens, Vulliermus de Yens, Jaquetus filius Stephani, Hugo filius Nycodi, Stephani filius Ansermi, Aymo filius dicti Bars, die Jovis ante festum Beati Johannis Battiste 1333, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi dominus Albone, apparently based on reconnaissances by their unnamed predecessors.

14v Johannes filius quondam Vulliermi Rogimont de Nyviduno domicelli, iii Ydus Marcii 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi dominus Albone.

14v Aymo filius quondam dicti Bar de Albona, iiii Ydus Marcii 1335, reconnaissance for Humbertus Alamandi dominus Albone, many parcels described in detail.

16 (In a different, probably later hand, and seemingly a complete transcript) Nos officialis curie Gebennensis, notum facimus universis, quod coram [nos] mandata nostro, videlicet Perreto dicto de Comugnie de Albona clerico curie nostre jurato ... personaliter constituto vir Illustrus Humbertus Alamandi dominus de Albone ex una parte, et Stephanus filius quondam Johannis de Monte domicellus ex altera, idem vero Stephanus sciens et spontaneus de jure suo... , in effect a

reconnaissance by Stephanus acting for himself and his brother Girardus, for the said Humbertus Alamandi, this is apparently the full text of the extract on fol. 1v, above, closing with the date tercio Ydus Marcii 1335.

17 (Resuming the previous hand) Vulliermus de Senarclens. Item est lictera sub data mense Julii 1299, quod Vulliermus de Senarclens domicellus filius quondam Domini Johannis de Senarclens militis, reconnaissance for Humbertus dominus de Thoyry et de Villar. (See above, fol. 7)

17 Johannes de Senarclens. Item, est lictera recepta per Perretum de Commugnyer notarium sub data 1339, quod Johannes filius quondam Nobilis Johannis de Senarclens militis intravit homagium Illustris Humberti Alamandi domini Albone modo et forma quilibet dictus miles olim intravit.

17 Johannes de Senarclens. Item, est lictera manu Perreti de Commugnyer notarii sub data 19 mar 1335, quod Nobilis Johannes de Senarclens domicellus filius quondam Jacobi de Senarclens recognovit se esse velle et debere esse hominem viri Nobilis Humberti Alamandi domini Albone.

18 (In a very different, later hand, likely 15th Century) Lictera homagii Johannis filii quondam Domini Nycholdi de Monte militis. Item, lictera confecta mense Maii anno domini millesimo ccc^{mo} nonagesimo secundo (May 1392, but the date is in error, the year should be 1292), quod predictus Johannes cepit in feudum ab illustri viro Domino Humberto domino de Thoyre et de Villar, videlicet avoyeriam quam predecessorum ipsius Johannis tenerunt et habuerunt et ipse Johannes habet et tenet in villa et territorio de Mollens et in hominibus existentibus in ipsis, followed by a detailed list of the said rights and properties. This is another version of the reconnaissance for Johannes de Monte on fol. 1, above.

18v Lictera homagii Stephani filii quondam Johannis de Monte domicelli. Item, lictera manu Perreti de Commugnyer de Albona notarii confecta date tercia Idus Marcii 1335, another version of the reconnaissance on fol. 1v, above, and also see fol. 16, above.

19 De renunciacione facta Stephano de Monte per hominibus suis de Mollens. Item, est lictera manu Perreti de Communier sub data prima die mensis Octobris 1343, cum Nobilis Dominus Humbertus Alamandi dominus Albone promictaverit Illustri viro et Potenti Domini Ludovico de Sabaudia domino Vaudi homines ipsius Stephani de Monte domicelli quos idem Stephanus habebat in villa de Mollens ipso Stephano consen... ? ,

Videlicet Merminodum filium quondam Reynardi Mayet qui debebant dicto Stephano racione sui tenementi 12 solidos Lausannenses census.

(Af1, fol. 4; Af 2, fol. 16v)

21v De homagio et feodo Johannis Humberti de Albona. Item, est lictera quod Johannes filius quondam Humberti burgensis Albone recognovit se tenere ... reconnaissance for Humbertus de Thoyry, list of properties, dicta lictera confecta et sub data mensis Septembris 1278, but the last word of the year is mostly covered by a dark stain. (Af 1, fol. 10v)

22v De feodo seu homagio Martini et Durandi de Bayoes. Item, est lictera sub data mensis Augusti 1294, quod Martinus et Durandus fratres filii Jacobi de Baioes made a reconnaissance for Humbertus de Thoyris et de Villar... (Af 1, fol. 11; Af 2, fol. 28v)

22v De concordia facta cum Stephano et Girardo de Albona. Item, est quedam lictera manu Rodulphi de Trivillins clerici confecta sub data die Veneris ante festum Beati Nycolay 1310, quod cum discordia verteretur inter Nobiles viros Johannem de Rossillione decanum Alingii, Remondum de Thoyris, et Petrum de Pringins procuratores et procuratorio nomine Illustri et Potentis viri Domini Amedei de Villaris ex una parte, Girardum et Stephanum de Albone dicti de Lausanna et Alexie matris eorundem et uxoris dicti Petri nomine dicte Alexie et dicti Petri ex altera super hereditate quondam Domini Petri Puctori cumdomini de Albona et super pluribus rebus aliis ad ipsam hereditatem spectantibus, de quibus tenebat idem Dominus Amedeus in manu sua ..., agreement, list of properties, mentioning some tenants and additional history. 24 De recognicione ...rini ? (evidently a few letters have been hidden by a crease in the paper – the text appears to give the missing name as Perrini) Claudii de Albona. Item, est quedam lictera sub data ii ? mensis Februarii 1283, quod Perrinus Claudius burgensis Albone recognovit se tenere de legio feodo illustris viri Humbert de Thoyris et de Villar.

24v (No title) Item, vi Idus Marcii 1335, Perrodus quondam filius Johannis de Ultralacum burgensis Albone et Perroneta eius uxor filia quondam Jaqueti Ros burgensis Albone vendiderunt perpetue Domino Humberto de Billens supradicto quandam peciam vinee ...

25 (Indistinct notation mentioning Johannes de Sivirier, not a document, but possibly a notation indicating what was to be placed here. In effect, this folio is the back cover of the volume, and might have no relation at all to the text of Af 3.)

25v (Notation: Pro domino Albone.)
