Johannes Maringo barbitonsor filius Jaqueti Maringo burgensis Paterniaci owes Dominus Johannes Innenas (?) procurator for the chapel of the Virgin Mary of Payerne, 26 mar 1470.

Petrus filius Tyobaldi Gerluaz (?) burgensis Paterniaci owes prefatus Dominus Johannes Innens (?), 30 mar 1470.

Mermetus Malliardo filius quondam Johannes (?)... sells to Johannes filius Francisci Mareschet?, 03 apr 1470 (this item badly stained and with some loss of paper in the last 6 lines), with other provisions.

Fol. 2v:

Frater (?) Rodulphus de Barra procurator for the convent (?) leases to ...? , badly stained and with some loss of paper as on fol. 2, with other provisions.

Fol. 3:

Johannes Chappuis cord... et burgensis Paterniaci owes Dompnus Johannes Innens procurator etc., cense, bequest of quondam Johannes Chappuis eius frater, 05 may 1470.

Othonetus de Viviaco de Montet prope Cudrifinno filius quondam Johannes de Viviaco dicti loci has received from Oliverius Ruerat de Corcellis burgensis Paterniaci, 25 livres, in deduction from a larger sum owed because of a purchase made by the said Othonetus and his wife Johanneta daughter of the late Huguetus Ruerat ..., ?? may 1470 (last part of this is badly stained)

(very faint, possibly further provisions for the above, obscured by the staining.)

Fol. 3v:

Johannes Ruerat filius Glaudii Ruerat de Corcellis burgensis Paterniaci, et Johannodus Meriex de Fouz (?) nomine et ad opus Nicolete filie sue ex altera, marriage, 16 may 1470, with release by bride.

Religiosus vir Frater Rodulphus de Barraz monachus, accensation for Johannes Cinglaz (?) de Gleterens nunc morans apud Poralbont (Port Albin) filius Jaqueti Cionglaz, same date.

Olyverius Fisicans de Corcellis burgensis Paterniaci with approval of Johanneta his wife, sells to Dompnus Johannes Innent procuror for the clergy, cense, from a bequest by the late Johannes Michael antenatus, 19? may 1470, with other provisions.

(Nobilis) Jacobus Gruz domicellus filius Petri Gruz quondam domicelli de Lustriaco sells to Petrus Bellot barbitonsor et burgensis Paterniaci, at Payerne, jx Alexia uxor Guaneti de Petra domicelli, datum ut supra, with other provisions.

Fol. 5:

Petrus Brulliod filius Jaqueti Brulliod alias Jacaud burgensis, sells to Dompnus Johannes Innens procurator etc., same date, long text, much of it not clearly legible.

Jaquetus Bellin clericus et burgensis Paterniaci with approval of his wife Francesia sells to Johannes Bosonet faber and burgensis Paterniaci, 08 oct 1470, with related provisions, same date, and with additional item recording receipt of payment by Jaquetus, 22 may 1470?

Fol. 5v:

Petrus Dodin filius quondam Jaqueti Dodin de Paterniaco with approval of his wife Perrissona sells to Dompnus Johannes Innens as procurer..., cense, 23 may 1470?, with other provisions.

Fol. 6:

Dompnus Nicodus Ossel capellanus Paterniaci filius quondam Petri Ossel sells to Dompnus Johannes Innens procurator etc., cense, property at Granges, ouz Muret, datum ut supra, with other provisions.

Fol. 6v:

Dispute between Agneta relict a quondam Jaqueti Gomaz filii quondam Petri Gomaz as tutrice for their children Petrus, Johannes, and Stephaneta, and Johannes Goma filius quondam Petri Gomaz and Petrus Gomaz filius quondam Johannes Gomaz, regarding her share of censes, same date.

Girardus Bachelaz filius quondam Petri Batchellard de Deller owes Dompnus Johannes Innens for the clergy, cense, 12 jun anno quo supra.

Johannes Jam antenatus filius quondam Jaqueti Jam de Corcellis with approval of his wife Alixone, owes Galcherius Daumont burgensis Paterniaci, 01 aug anno quo supra, with other provisions dated 03 aug anno quo supra.

08 aug 1470, agreement or accounting? among the domini capellani of Payerne, videlicet Vuilliermus Tabusset, Vuilliermus ..., (not clear how to parse the list), versus Aymonetus Pictet clericus Paterniaci et admodiator dictorum capellanorum omnium censum et emolumentorum ..., with additional agreements?

Nobilis Guionetus de Pont owes Johannes de Stabulo nutrite quondam Petri de Stabulo Paterniaci, cense, 25 sep 1470 (clear).

Dompnus Johannes Innens cappellanus Paterniaci for the clergy (list) have received from Jaquetus Anthoyne de Staviaco morans apud Dompnumpetrum Parvum (?), regarding a sale?, 04 oct 1470.

Jaquetus Bellin clericus et burgensis Paterniaci has received from his wife Francesia 40 livres, dotis, assignal, 08 oct 1470.

Frater Girardus Banqueta olim procurer has received from Oliverius Fissicans de Corcellis for purchase of property of the late Humbertus Rappinat, same date.

Vuilliermus Tabusset, Vuilliermus de Ponthoux alias Uldri, Johannes Puppon, Petrus Bersard, et Nicodus Osel, capellani of the chapel of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Payerne, Petrus Girard, Petrus Moroni, et Petrus de Mediavilla clerici Paterniaci, aggrement with Johannes Innens regarding censes, 08 nov 1470.

Girardus Mehani clericus filius quondam Girardus Mehani burgensis Paterniaci has received for the dowry of Katherine his wife filia Jaqueti Anthoine de Staviaco clerici, 80 livres, assignal, 23 dec 1470, with other provisions.

Petrus Chappuis de Corcellis burgensis Paterniaci filius quondam Johannes Chappuis sells to Dompnus Johannes Innens procurator, cense, 09 jan 1470, with other provisions.

Fol. 13:

Prefatus Petrus Chappuis owes Aymonetus Pictet clericus et burgensis Paterniaci, same date, with other provisions.

Fol. 13v:

Nicodus Probi procurator nomine abbacie monasterii Paterniaci has received from Petrus Chevrod filius quondam Jaqueti Chevrod de Missiez full payment ..., 14 jan 1470.

Petrus Nybloz burgensis Paterniaci and Agneta relict a quondam Jaqueti Gomaz de Fitignyez, marriage, she with approval of her sons by the late Jaqueti Gomaz, Johannes and Petrus, 19 jan 1470, with other provisions.

Fol. 14v:

Bartholomeus Nibloz filius prefati Petri Nibloz et quondam Marguerete uxoris sue filie quondam Mermeti Ramus de Sancto Albino en Vuilliez, with approval of the said Petrus Nibloz, and Petrus et Johannes Gomaz liberos quondam Jaqueti Gomaz de Fitignye nomine et ad opus Anthonie sororis sue, marriage, 19 jan 1470, with other provisions.

Fol. 15v:

Huguetus Jam filius quondam Jaqueti Jam de Corcellis burgensis Paterniaci sells with approval of Marguereta his wife, Petrus their son, and Johannes Jam junior his brother, various properties at Corcelles, 06 jan 1470, with other provisions.

Fol. 16:

Petrus Gayet burgensis Paterniaci sells with approval of Girardus Grissonet alias Cussins? coadjutor... to Petrus de Malliez filius quondam Johannis de Malliez burgensis Paterniaci, 24 jan 1470, with other provisions.

Fol. 16v:

Ansermoz Brunetaz de Corcellis burgensis Paterniaci owes Petrus Gayet, 10 feb 1470.

Aymonetus Pictet procurator et Nobilis vir Jacobus Gruz de Lustriaco, dispute about donations and bequests owed to the convent? (from the de Mallet family?), 14 feb 1470.

Fol. 17v:

Prefatus Jacobus Gruz sells to Dompnus Johannes Innens procurator, censes owed by various persons listed: Henricus Curtilliard, Stephanus Brossier, 14 feb 1470, with later annotation 03 aug 1471, also additional provisions.

Fol. 18:

Jaquetus Anthoine de Staviaco nunc morans apud Dompnumpetrum Parvum has received from Jaquetus Bellin clericus Paterniaci 100 sols in deduction from a larger sum, same date, and further provisions at the bottom of the page.

Petrus Girard clericus et burgensis Paterniaci has received from the said Jaquetus Anthoine 100 sols in deduction from a larger sum, same date.

Fol. 18v:

Girardus Morel burgensis Paterniaci has received from Jacobus Mellez Paterniaci full payment for a previous sale, 25 feb 1470.

Petrus Chaucy filius quondam Roleti Chaucy de Montagniaci sells to Jacobus Mellez burgensis Paterniaci, cense due at St. Andreas per Berrardum Chaucy eius fratrem, 02 mar 1470 (is this the same Berard Chaucy who was the notary at Friburg?), with other provisions.

Fol. 19:

Prefatus Petrus Chaucy sells to prefatus Berrardus Chaucy eius frater, cense, same date, with other provisions, and a related accensation.

Fol. 19v:

Petrus Chaucy has received from his brother Berrardus Chaucy 15 florins owed to him (rec. Jaquetus Bellin), 06 mar 1470.

Petrus de Mediavilla clericus filius quondam Petri de Mediavilla burgensis Paterniaci ex una, et Agnes relicta dicti quondam Petri de Mediavilla ex alia, she requests payment from him, reference to marriage contract of the late Petrus, but she does not call the younger Petrus her son, settlement, 07 apr 1471.

Fol. 20:

Johannes Chapuis corderius et burgensis Paterniaci sells to Dompnus Johannes Innens, cappellanus Paterniaci procurer etc., cense, 21 apr 1471, with other provisions.

Fol. 20v :

Girardus Pictet sutor filius Johannis Pictet sutoris burgensis Paterniaci, sells to Dompnus Johannes Innens etc., cense, same date, with other provisions.

Petrus de la Crousaz de Gravaul (=Grandvaux) parrochie Villette, quod cum Johannes de Pontoux alias Uldri faber owed cense, ..., 29 apr 1471, with other provisions.

Fol. 21 :

Aymonetus Pictet clericus owes Dompnus Johannes Innens 14 jun 1471.

Petrus Gavarret corderius filius quondam Roleti Gavarret reprehendisse de morte quondam Petri de Foucignye domicelli et Margareta eiusdem relicta tanquam usufructuaria..., same date.

Petrus de Fonte alias ...blet de Magnens for his wife Jaqueta daughter of the late _____ Leuwaz? de ...?, and Johannes Dursum (Durson) dicti loci ? , dispute and settlement, 08 jul 1471.

Margareta filia quondam Vuilliermi Mareschet as tutor for her children by the late Petrus de Foucignye domicelli, reprehendit et replacitavit de morte et obitu dici Petri quis viri in manibus Nicodi Thome locumtenentis advocatie Paterniāiaci ... Jaqueti Bertho ... 15 jul 1471.

29 aug 1471, Dompnus Girardus Mureti vice decanus de Adventhica (ecclesiastical matters?), same date.

Berhardus Chaucy filius quondam Roleti Chaucy de Montagniaco le Mont, owes debts?, 14 sep 1471, etc. ?

Fol. 24 :

Vuilliermus de Viviaco de Montet prope Cudriffinum, filius quondam Johannes de Viviaco , and Jaqueta filia Nicodi Cuenet notarii et burgensis Adventhica relictāque Petri David de Yverduno, marriage, 05 nov 1471.

Ansermus Bruneta, Octhinetus et Henricus Rappin de Corcellis tanquam heredes videlicet dictus Ansermus in medietate et dicti Octhinetus et Henricus Rappin in alias medietate omnium et singulorum bonorum quondam Petri Gayet burgensis Paterniāiaci (who died intestate), donation to the monastery, 30 jan 1471, followed by a related transaction between Ansermus and the Rappin heirs, same date.

Johannes Crostel filius quondam Johannes Crostel filii quondam Hugueti Crostel burgensis Paterniāiaci, and Glaudius Advoye filius quondam Johannes Advoye clericus burgensis Paterniāiaci nomine et ad opus Ysabelle filie sue, marriage, 01 feb 1471, with release by bride.

Johannes Brossier filius Stephani Brossier de Corcellis owes cense to Ludovicus dou Müllini filius Petri dou Mullin burgensis Friburgo for purchase of livestock?, 09 mar 1471.

Johanneta filia quondam Johannis Cusard (Cussard) uxor Johannis de Vaalengino ... et burgensis Paterniaci, et Johanneta uxor Glaudii Michie, quitclaim to Henrieta their sister wife of Petrus Guigniard, for all claim on inheritance from their father Johannes Cussard, also mention of their mother Jaqueta, 16 mar 1471.

The said Jaqueta relict Johannis Cussard filii quondam Vuilliermi Cussard, quitclaim to the said Henrieta, same date.

Johannes Musi de Corsere owes Frater Rodulpho de Barra procurator etc., 19 mar 1471.

Fol. 26a verso :

Francesia filia Johannes Fabri et quondam Agnetis eius uxoris filie quondam Henrici Pudraul, owes Dompnus Johannes Innens procurator etc., 23 mar 1471, with related transaction indicating that Francesia is now the wife of Vuillierumus Gevel ? (possibly Gonel?), 24 mar 1471.

Fol. 26b:

Another transaction involving the same parties, the name of the husband of Francesia looks more like Gonel in this act, 23 mar 1471.

Nobilis Guygo de Loyes owes Dompnus Johannes Innens etc., cense owed by the late Nycolletus Savary and his son Othetus, 08 apr 1472.

Fol. 26b verso:

Johannes Chapuis corderius et burgensis Paterniaci owes Nicodus Probi clericus et burgensis Paterniaci, for purchase of a horse, 29 apr 1472, with other provisions.

Johannes Muvilliat filius quondam Othonodi Muvilliat burgensis Paterniaci, quod cum dictus Othonodus eius pater owes cense to Alexia filia quondam Johannes Crostel filii quondam Jaqueti Crostel uxor Guioneti de Petra domicelli Paterniaci, unum gerdile ... jx Petri Bovet, uncertain exactly what is happening here, the act is heavily abbreviated, 19 apr 1472.

Fol. 27:

Jaquetus Bachepalla alias Corde burgensis Paterniaci owes Dompnus Johannes Innens procurator etc., cense ?, reference to something sold to the clergy by quondam Jaqueti Corde et Alexia his

wife, several items with many names of adjacent owners, 22 apr 1472. Fols. 27v and 28 are blank, this item ends on fol. 28v.

Fol. 28v:

Venerabilis et religious vir Dompnus Petrus de Espagnye sacrista of the monastery, accensation for 9 years to Petrus Mehani carpenthator et burgensis Paterniaci, a mill belonging to the said monastery vocata Molendina Canalium, 18 may 1472.

Johanneta relicta quondam Johannis dou Marest et Petrus dictorum conjugum filius, sell to Petrus Ruerat filius quondam Johannis Ruerat de Corcellis burgensis Paterniaci, unam posam, at Corcelles, en Cillion, 24 may 1472, with other provisions.

Fol. 29:

Die 24 jun 1472, Vuilliermus Girard ... in capitulo monasteries Paterniaci ... , ecclesiastical business? , mention of a mill.

Nobilis Johannes de Mont advocatus Paterniaci, similar to the previous item, 04 jul 1472.

Girardus Advoye clericus et burgensis Paterniaci owes Dompnus Johannes Innens etc., cense, 08 jun 1472.

Fol. 29v :

Jaquetus Jam filius Johannis Jam antenati owes with approval of Petrus Vionet de Corcellis, cense, to Dompnus Johannes Innens etc., at Corcelles en Rombosson, 13 jul 1472.

Petrus Chapuis de Corcelis filius quondam Johannis Chapuis owes cense to Dompnus Johannes Innenes etc., at Corcelles, ou Poudaix, jx heirs of quondam Francesia relicta Berthod ? Nibolz, 28 jul 1472.

Petrus Chaucy filius quondam Roleti Chaucy de Montagniaco owes Dompnus Rodulphus de Barra monk, for remainder of price of purchase of a red horse, 31 aug 1472.

Anthonius Mecza corderius et burgensis Paterniaci with approval of **Vuilliermus Tyndroz alias Pucel** has received from **Mermeta dilecta uxor sua filia quondam Ansermi Ansel** burgensis Paterniaci quondam per dar sua et dot nomine (?) videlicet 30 livres, assignal, 01 sep 1472.

Fol. 30:

Petrus Jacoz de Grangia d'Espinez ? owes Ludovicus de Molendino burgensis Friburgi remaining 3 florins for purchase of a horse, 09 sep 1472.

Dompnus Vuilliermus de Pontoux alias Uldry sells to Dompnus Johannes Innens etc., cense, 11 sep 1472 (this item difficult to read, bleed-through). with other provisions.

Fol. 30v:

Frater Rodulphus de Barra procurer etc., accensation for **Henricus dou Tez (=Dutoit) de Corcellis**, casale situm in territorio de Corcellies loco dicto en la Monnerechoz prope Wadum eis Segnens juxta casale liberorum quondam Ansermi Ansel quod modo tenet Stephanus Brossiex a vento et casale quondam Nicodi Vant quod modo tenet Vuilliermus Rolant a borea et affrontat vie publice tendete ad pascuam dictam Pasquye Vondu ? , 28 nov 1472, with other provisions.

Ysabella filia Girardi Grissonet alias Cussine relictia Johannis Conte de Corgiz filii Anthonii Contoz dicti loci burgensis Paterniaci with approval of the said Girardus her father... in the name of their children, difficult to read, possibly Ysabella is ceding property to Anthonius Contoz, 01 dec 1472, with other provisions.

Fol. 31:

... (? name left blank, then a word beginning with F, reading uncertain) vice castellanus Montagniaci, accensation to Johannes Chapuis corderius et burgensis Paterniaci for one year, possibly relating to the dime of the Château de Montagny, 01 dec 1472.

Dompnus Petrus de Espagnye sacrista approves purchase by Anthonio Vaulery alias Bacon morantis apud Corcellis from Petrus Chapuis de Corcelles, property that had previously belonged (?) to (or perhaps had been donated by?) the heirs of the late Hugueti Crostel and the late Francesia his wife and recognized (?) by Johannes son of Johannes son of the said Hugueti Crostel, 11 dec 1472.

A related item? for Stephanus Brossier, same date.

Fol. 31v:

Dompnus Jacobus de Trevaul cappellanus et curattus parrochie de Pentaz filius Petri de Trevaul sutoris et burgensis Paterniaci, ecclesiastical matters ? with the chaplains of the chapel of the Virgin Mary at Payerne ?, 14 dec 1472.

Fol. 32:

Frater Rodulphus de Barra procurator etc. leases to Petrus Rappinat filius Johannes Rappinat de Corcellis, 25 dec 1472.

Oliverius Ruerat filius quondam Jaqueti Ruerat de Corcellis burgensis Paterniaci sells to Othonetus de Viviaco filius quondam Johannes de Viviaco de Montet, cense, 03 jan 1472, with other provisions.

Quod cum Johanneta relictā quondam Johannodi Grilliet de Fitignyer made bequest for the remedy of his soul etc. in parrochiam ecclesiam beati Petri de Trevaul, cense of 6 sols, to be paid? by her son Petrus, now? Dompnus Petrus Pictet filius dicte Johannete et frater maternis dicti Petri Grilliet curatus de Trevaul acknowledges receipt from the said Petrus Grilliet frater meus maternus, the said 6 sols, 15 jan 1472.

Fol. 33:

Frater Rodulphus de Barra procurator, accensation for 3 years to Henricus dou Tel (=Dutoit) de Corcellis, mill at Corcelles, super rippam Albonie, 22 jan 1472.

Petrus Morin alias Girard burgensis Paterniaci sells to Petrus Bersard? rector of the hospital, cense, 19 feb 1472, with other provisions.

Petrus Chaucy filius quondam Roleti Chaucy de Montagniaco owes Nicodus Probi clericus et burgensis Paterniaci regarding a debt of his brother Anthonius Chaucy, 25 feb 1472.

Fol. 33v:

Anthonius de Grivillies (?) alias Rossé de Magnens sells to Petrus Chaucy filius quondam Roleti Chaucy de Montagniaco, cense, same date, with other provisions.

Dompnus Johannes Innens procurator etc., relates to a cense due from Petrus Bersard ?, die Lune 17 mar 1472, later notation die Jovis 03 sep 1473.

Petrus Goma de Fitignye filius quondam Johannis Goma dicti loci has received from his wife Ysabella filia quondam Petri Lombard de Dompdidier by Petri de Oleir ? tutor for Girardus Lombard minoris etatis filii quondam Johannis Lombard filii predicti Petri, nomine dotis ipsius Ysabelle, 30 florins, assignal, 18 mar 1472.

Petrus Chapuis de Corcellis filius quondam Johannis Chapuis owes cense to Dompnus Johannes Innens etc., same date, with other provisions.

Petrus Chevroz de Corcellis filius quondam Ochtheti Chevroz burgensis Paterniaci sells to Dompnus Johannes Innens etc., cense, same date., with later notation in margin indicating the year 1473.

Fol. 34v:

Francesia filia Johannis Fabri et quondam Agnetis filie quondam Henrici Pudraul uxor Vuilliermi Gonel de Rota with approval of her husband, quod cum Guilliermeta filia quondam Johannis Paulor (?) uxor Nicodi Jayod owed cense to the said Agneta her mother (rec. Girardus de Valle 20 dec 1436), agreement between Guilliermeta and Francesia, 19 apr 1473.

Fol. 35:

Dompnus Johannes Innens procurator etc. accensation for Johannes Gillabert morans apud Corcellis, 26 apr 1473.

Roletus Mestre de Suprapetrum sartor, and Johannes Bergo for his daughter Glaudia, marriage, 26 apr 1473, with release by bride.

Dictus Roletus Mestre has received from Clauda his wife by her father Johannes Bergo, 22 livres, assignal, same date.

Johannes Innenes procurator, accensation for Jaquetus Jam filius Johannis Jam de Corcellis, at Corcelles, en Wawraz, 4 poses, 07 may 1473, with other provisions.
