

# **ACV Ff 96 Les fiefs procédés tans des nobles de Lullin, seigneurs de Vulliens, que de Noble Isabelle de Bussy, de Romont, indivis pour le quart, 1551.**

In effect, a reconnaissance or quernet for these fiefs. The inventory of the ACV indicates some sections of the reconnaissance are found in Fn 86 and Fn 218. There are three separate sections. So far, the source of the date seems to be a notation on one of the labels on the spine of the volume “Signé par vidimus par Mr. le Commissaire General Zerkinden, anno 1551”, and on the title page, “Livre i<sup>er</sup> Moudon, extraict des extentes stipulées en faveur de L.E. cause ayants du Sr. de Lullin Sr. de Vulliens par Egrege Collon commissaire...”

Fn 86 is a terrier for the seigneurie of Vulliens, compiled by François Collon, not signed, “du bien et revenu de la seigneurie et juridiction de Vulliens appartenant à mes Tresredoubtés et Souverains Seigneurs de Berne en vigueur de la juste conquête du Pays de Vuaud et deppendances d’iceluy”, circa 1548. There is a section for Chavannes, fols. 142v-156v, containing what appear to be the complete reconnaissances corresponding to the section summarized below, but nevertheless not signed. Fn 218 concerns the former priory of Montpreveyres, not relevant to the properties at Chavannes. The previous reconnaissances, for Noble Aymon de Genève, might be those in Fn 65 and Fn 68, but the commissaires noted in the inventory of the ACV are Ludovicus Challet and Jacobus Gaudini, not Johannes Luysii as indicated in Fn 86.

FamilySearch images 1263-1292 are the repertoires for the 3 sections.

“A” section: The “A” section begins with a short “endomayne”.

Chavannes, fols. 300-326, also a few possible items that might relate to properties or families from Chavannes in sections for Moudon (images 603 ff.).

300 Chavanes sus Mouldon

300 Claude du Tey filz de feu Pierre du Tey de Chavanes sus Mouldon, no date on this or any of the other “reconnaissances in this section; in effect, these are summaries. (Fn 86, fol. 142v, 16 nov 1547, citing a previous reconnaissance for Spectable et Magnifique Seigneur Aymé de Genesve chevallier seigneur de Lullin, de Vulliens etc. by the said Claude du Tey, commissaire Discret Jehan Luysy. Fn 86 also shows, in the margins of the reconnaissances for Chavannes, folio numbers from a “gross” into which these were apparently copied, ranging from fols. 1 to 91, these numbers scattered and not in sequence.)

previous reconnaissance by Nycod et Claude Veriz à leurs noms et de Roz et Pierre Veriz es mains de feu Discret Jehan Luysy.)

310v Le dessus nommé Pierre Veriz alias du Russel... (Fn 86, fol. 148, 24 oct 1548, citing a previous reconnaissance by Marmet de Costel alias Belaz es mains de feu Discret Jehan Luysy.)

312 Claude Veriz agissant comme personne conjoicte de Jacquemaz sa femme... (Fn 86, fol. 149, 24 oct 1548, citing a previous reconnaissance by Françoysse, mother of his wife Jaquemaz ?)

312v Mauris du Tey de Chavanes... (Fn 86, fol. 149v, 24 oct 1548, citing a previous reconnaissance by his father Claude du Tey l'aisné es mains de feu Discret Jehan Luysy.)

(In Fn 86, but not here in Ff 96 ? Fol. 151v, for Loys Belaz alias de Costel et de Pierre et Claude Belaz alias de Costel de Chavanes sus Mouldon, citing a previous reconnaissance by Jehan Belaz leur predecesseur es mains de feu Discret Jehan Luysy, no date indicated, but probably also 24 oct 1548.)

318 Pierre et Jehan du Tey freres filz de feu Nycod du Tey de Chavanes pour la moytié, Rolet vilz de feu Guy du Tey et Jehan du Tey son frere... (Fn 86, fol. 152v, 28 oct 1548 citing a previous reconnaissance by Guy et Pierre du Tey es mains de feu Discret Jehan Luysy.)

324 Françoysse fille de feu Pierre de Coster de Chavanes vefve de feu Jehnan de Mont cordannier et bourgeois de Mouldon comme femme franche et libere... (Fn 86, fol. 155v, 27 nov 1548, citing her previous reconnaissance es mains de feu Discret Jehan Luysy.)

325v La susnommée Françoysse fille de feu Pierre de Coster... (Fn 86, fol. 156v, citing a previous reconnaissance by Pierre Demont es mains que dessus, not date indicated, but probably also 27 nov 1548.)
