

ACV Fh 106 Recogniciones nobilis et potentis viri Johannis condomini Albone, recepte per Petrum Colovrat et Stephanum de Lavignier notarios, 1321-1340.

The first folio, bearing the above title, contains an index of places. There is also an old notation at the top, “Nº 2”. The volume was also known as **6** (on the spine of the volume). The verso of fol. 1 lists additional items relating to the first reconnaissance, which begins on fol. 2. Folio 1 is in effect the flyleaf; folio 2 bears a longer title, “Extenta facta super reddictis et et extensis ? illustris viri Johannis condomini de Albona mense novembris anno domini millesimo tercentesimo vicesimo primo” (November, 1321), a short but uninformative introduction, and then the first reconnaissance. Many of the persons named as adjacent tenants in this volume have no surnames; in some cases, surnames were inserted later, in a different hand. Can any of these short reconnaissances be matched with those in later terriers? In some cases, the names and relationships here are likely to be significant in tracing the origins of later families and surnames.
