

ACV Fh 200 Extracts of reconnaissances for the Confratria Sancti Spiritus de Gimel of Pierre Gos  
compiled 12 feb 1546 by Michel Collat

“Extractus recognitiones confrarie Sancti Spiritus de Gimel sumptus super recognitionibus per quondam egregium Petrum Gos notarium Albonne receptis factus per me Michaelem Collacti notarium et burgensem Albonne anno M<sup>o</sup> v<sup>c</sup> xlvi<sup>o</sup> et die xii februarii. (signature: Michel Collat, with paraphe)”

There are tiny, highly abbreviated insertions and marginal notations probably indicating later tenants of specific properties. These have not been studied in detail. Some of the entries are quite short, apparently summaries of the originals.

A long series of the transactions in this volume appear to be extracted from Fh 199. However, not everything in Fh 199 is found in Fh 200. Among the exceptions, at fol. 29 in Fh 199 is a transaction involving Petrus Billiard de Gimel and Ludovicus de Gebennis morans apud Gimel ex una parte, and Nycollectus Champion de Gimel as prior of the Confratrie ex parte altera, 26 jun 1468.

- 2      Petri Champion, same date (anno, die, loco, et presentibus etc.), mention his uncle Johanne Champion
- 3      Johannis Maruglerii, no indication of date, with undated marginal notation next to one property, “tenet Jacobus de Gebennis alias Favroz”, presumably indicating that it was later purchased by Jaques de Genève alias Favre.
- 4      Claudi Boley, same date (anno et die quibus supra), mentions his father Johannes Bolley
- 4v     Petri Ganieret (=Gagnerat) alias Martin de Gimel, no indication of date.
- 5      **Georgii Savariod (Georgii filii Petri Savario de Gimel)**, no indication of date, pretestu recognitionis actenus facte per Roletum Ruffy de Gimel, videlicet duas posas terre sitas in territorio de Gimel loco dicto en Coudrey juxta terram Johannis Genevey a lacu, terram Arthaudy Champion et eius uxoris a juria, pratum dicti confitentis a borea, et quendam russellum a vento, pro quibus duobus posis terre debere confitetur, videlicet unam cupam cum dyminia frumenti communis mensure predice census. (Marginal notation at the beginning of the reconnaissance says “tenet Anthonius de Gebennis alias Billiard et dicit redemisse et debet edocere.”)

6 Anthonii Alamand commorantis apud Saubraz su et Roleto filii quondam Petri de la Crousaz de Saubraz nominibus, no indication of date.

6v Johannis de Lysel alias Christini de Santo Hengendo de Roctieres (=St.Oyens), no indication of date, previously by Nycoletus and Stephanus Christini of the said place.

7 Nycolleti Champion, same date (anno et die premissis), based on a donation by Jacquemetam filiam Thome Escoffeyis relictam Johannis Morel, also another donation by Janam matrem eiusdem Nycolleti confitentis, etc.

7v (The script changes here.) “Confession pour la communauté de Gimel contre les hoirs de Collect Rosey”, 20 feb 1548, “conste l’instrument par egrege Michiel Collact receipt”.

8 Johannis Maniglerii, “Vendicio Johannis Magniglerii in extractu fo. Primo”, 25 jul 1511, Johannes Maniglerii de Gimel sells to Ludovico Benedicti de Gimel representing the Confratrie Sancti Spiritus que fit apud Gimel, recorded by Discret Jacob de Fougia de Comugny resident of Gimel, notary. (This is likely the same transaction found in **Fh 199, fol. 1**, where the page is badly damaged but portions still legible.)

8v « Vendicio Glaudii filii Petri du Rosey, Stephani eius filii, folio primo », 01 feb 1510, Glaudius filius quondam Petri douz Rosey de Gimel sells to Jacob Gagnerat and Johannes de Gebennis as priors of the Confratrie Sancti Spiritus que sit apud Gimel, by the same notary. (Apparently this sale is found in Fh 199, fol. 1v.)

9 « Vendicio Johannis Magniglerii folio ii », 17 jun 1497, Johannes Maniglerii de Gimel sells to Nycolletus Champion et Georgius Savariodi acting as priors of the Confratrie Sancti Spiritus que fit apud Gimel, recorded by the same notary, Jacobus de Fougia. (The reference is to Fh 199, fol. 2.)

10 Johannis Huguetaz de Albona, fabri, albergement, 21 jun 1486, same notary as above, Petrus Gagnerat of Gimel acting as prior of the Confratrie leases to Johanni Huguetaz, domum cum ochia in the village of Gimel juxta viam publicam that runs from the church toward the house of Ludovici de Gebennis a vento. (Fh 199, fol. 2v)

11 Stephani Monthouz, “donatio”, 20 mar 1479, same notary as above, Stephanus filius quondam Petri Monthouz de Gimel ex una parte, et Petrus Mariglerii as prior of the Confratrie Sancti Spiritus de Gimel ex parte altera, property jx terram Nycolleti Girardi alias du Bugnion. (This reconnaissance is found in Fh 199, fol. 4.)

12 Johannis Maliez alias Jannet, “donatio”, 23 may 1485, same notary as above, Johannes Maliez alias Janet de Gimel to Ludovico de Gebennis et Georgio filio Petri Benedicti as priors of the Confratrie. (Fh 199, fol. 5)

13 Francisci Huguetaz, “donatio”, 15 jun 1485, Franciscus Huguetaz alias Alamand to Ludovicus de Gebennis and Georgius Benedicti as priors of the Confratrie, mentions his brother Anthonius Huguetaz alias Alamand habitator de Saubraz (same notary?). (Fh 199, fol. 5v)

14 Claudii Magnuglerii, “confessio”, 05 mar 1482, Glaudius filius quondam Johannis Maniglerii de Gimel ex una parte et Petrus Gagnerate de eodem ex altera parta (acting as prior of the Confratrie), mentions his mother Francesia widow of Jacobi Crotier pro remedio of her soul, notary not named. (Fh 199, fol. 6v)

15 Claudi du Bugnyon, « vendicio », 17 jun 1482, Glaudius douz Bugnyon de Gimel ex una parte et Glaudius Bollet de eodem acting as prior of the Confratrie, same notary as above. (Fh 199, fol. 7v)

16 Johannis Maliez alias Jannet, « vendicio Johannis Maliez alias Janet fo. viii », 17 jun 1482, Johannes Malliez alias Janet de Gimel ex una parte et Glaudius douz Bougnyon et Glaudius Bolley de eodem acting as priors and rectors of the Confratrie, same notary as above. (The reference is to Fh 199, fol. 8)

17 **Ludovici de Gebennis alias Billiard, “Albergamentum Ludovici de Gebennis alias Billiard fo. ix », 17 dec 1498, Glaudius Bolley de Gimel acting as prior of the Confratrie leases to Ludovicus de Gebennis alias Billiard de eodem, with consent of several other members of the Confratrie, same notary as above. (Original in Fh 199, fol. 9)**

19 Nycolleti du Bugnyon, “Albergamentum Nycolleti du Bugnyon fol. x (?) », 03 may 1493, Petrus Gagnerat de Gimel as prior of the Confratrie leases to Nycolletus filius quondam Girardi du Bugnion, with consent of several other members of the Confratrie including Petri de Gebennis, same notary as above.

20 Johannis et Benedicti Magniglerii, “vendicio”, 27 apr 1511, Johannes et Benedictus Maniglerii fratres sell to Glaudio Malliez as prior of the Confratrie, jx pratum Petri de Gebennis. Also second sale 29 may 1499, Johannis et Benedictus Maniglerii de Gimel, fratres, sell to Petrus de Gebennis alias Billiard de eodem acting as prior and rector of the Confratrie.

71 **Jaqueti et Petri de Gebennis de Beria, « confessio », 18 feb 1405, Jaquetus et Petrus de Gebennis de Beria fratres owe 6 florins each feast of St. Michael as a result of a sale (in effect a mortgage). Property securing the loan is not described, but it must be subject to the confratrie of Gimel. Witnesses not named, see Fh 199.** (The date is likely in error, through the omission of a word in the original in Fh 199. The most likely solution, based on the persons mentioned and their known relationships, is 1485 or 1495.)

Bv      31 jul 1481?, notary Stephanus Germagniez, Petrus Joffrey alias douz Mex de Gimel to Ludovycus de Gebennis alias Billiard as prior.

D      last day of month of ... 1467, notary Johannes Mallie? of Aubonne, Johannes Boleys de Gimel ex una parte, and Girardus Gagnerat dicti loci as prior.

Dv      21 of Ju... 1486, notary Jacobus de Fogia, Petrus Gagnerat de Gimel as prior, and Johannes Huguetaz de Albona. (see fol. 10 above)
