Only the index and introductory material were initially copied. Notes by the ACV indicate later additions to 1483 and call the commissaire Petrus Barichet, even though his name is clearly written Petrimanus Burichet in the text. As of 1437, the rector of the chapel was Frater Petrus Berthodi. There are two separate sections in the text, designated “A” and “B” by the ACV, numbered separately, each with its own index. Now that the digitized images are available, more details can be extracted.

A great number of the obligations recorded here, in spite of the various ways they are expressed in the terminology of the day, were in fact loans by the hospital to individuals at 5% simple interest with no term. These obligations were perpetual, the annual interest being paid sometimes for generations, until a redemption or “rehemption” was made by a separate repayment of the original principal. The hospital, as was the custom at the time, served as a banker or mortgage lender and supported its activities through its interest income.

The structure of this volume is possibly less complicated than it appears. The main part of the “A” section appears to include fol. 1-208v only, intended as reconnaissances and other instruments recorded for the benefit of Frater Petrus Berthodi, rector of the hospital, whose tenure extended at least until 1461, and then in 1464 for his successor, Frater Leonardo de Castanea.

The main part of the “B” section includes fol. 1-235 (but fol. 225-235 are a duplication of fol. 209-218v, with some blank folios intervening – the “B” section thus properly ends at fol. 218v), consisting of reconnaissances and other instruments recorded for the benefit of Frater Leonardus de Castanea, commenced by the same Petrimanus Burichet die Mercurii post festum Sancti Galli Confessoris 1464. In other words, the “A” and “B” sections constitute two successive terriers or inventories for the properties and rents subject to the hospital. They overlap, to the extent that material from the tenure of Frater Leonardus de Castanea was also added to the earlier “A” terrier begun in 1437.

The remaining material is harder to characterize, but the additional folios from the “A” section and from the “B” section seem to belong together. Together, they contain a series of folios numbered 1-47 (at least one of those missing), plus additional, unnumbered folios and some stray scraps of paper that are now attached or inserted. The numbered portion of this material has an associated repertorium that validates the internal foliation. It contains a sort of digest of materials from the “B” section, but at fol. 45 a series of items from the 1480’s is found. It is not yet clear if the unnumbered folios form a continuous sequence, or if they all belong together at all, but they include mainly items from the 1480’s as well, possibly a continuation from fol. 47.

Once it was realized that the numbered folios from the end of the “B” section belonged with the numbered folios from the end of the “A” section, we moved all of these miscellaneous folios from the “B” section to the appropriate place in the analysis of the “A” section, with indications of where each folio is placed in the physical volume as it exists today. These pages – the entire “rentier” section – might best be characterized as rough notes and preparatory material for the next terrier, compiled by Petrus Burichet for Frater Glaudius Petrodi, then rector of the hospital, now catalogued as Fn 319, with dates 1480-1483. (Fn 319 lacks all introductory material and does not seem to cover all of the territories represented in Fn 316, so it may be that additional volumes in the same series have been lost.)

Preceding terriers include Fn 313, at least in part (one of the sections of Fn 313 is an inventory of documents in favor of the hospital compiled by Frater Leonardus de Castanea himself, organized into “fardelli” or bundles).

(ACV fols. 209-293 comprise a separate subsection, still apparently part of the « A » section, with manuscript folio numbers 1-47, then 5 unnumbered folios, followed by an index (ACV fols. 292-293) to this section (repertorium huius libri), referencing the manuscript folio numbers starting with 1 and continuing to 40. Because the index refers separately to this section, we follow the separate foliation. This small section is followed by the « B » section, with a separate foliation beginning with 1, ACV fol. B 1. It will be observed that this section duplicates or summarizes the items at the beginning of the « A » section. The ACV considers this subsection a « rentier rière les mêmes lieux, 1480, 1483 », in spite of the presence of dates as early as 1437, and with the signature and paraphe of Petrimanus Burichet as late as 1465. The material from 1480-1483 and later, with at least one item dated 1510, in addition to one marginal notation dated 1511, looks more like an effort to maintain an inventory of the documents in favor of the hospital, rather than a « rentier », a record of the amounts due from each individual .)

(The text for the above item ends at the top of fol. 235, ACV 202. None of the folios that follow bear numbers from the main sequence of the « B » section. The image indicated as ACV 202v appears to show a blank page with a very faded half-sheet in a different hand containing descriptions of three properties somewhere in the vicinity of Moudon, apparently not a part of what precedes or follows. The next images are numbered and are recognizable as fols. 41-44 from the « rentier » section of the « A » section of Fn 316, beginning with items for Forel, from 1464. As these few additional pages of the « B » section appear to belong with the « rentier » part of the « A » section, we have moved all of them to that section, above, indicating by the prefix B their origin here.)
